WP5 OBJECTIVES

- To guarantee long-term impact of the project activities/results, i.e. continuation, share and replication
- To be replicated at local/regional scales (beyond the territorial/administrative limits of the pilot area) and at Mediterranean level (national authorities)

WP5 DELIVERABLES

- > 5.2.1 Transferability plan at Pilot areas and sub-national scale: country-level (6 Plans)
- > 5.2.2 Transferability plan at Pilot areas and sub-national scale: transboundary (6 Plans)
- In parallel to this, CO-EVOLVE partners are involved in several initiatives and exploring other opportunities to fund the replication of the project's activities

- Preparing for the implementation of **concrete pilot actions**, such as for examples recovery of beach dunes, dredging with sediment reuse for nourishment, lodging prototypes, differentiated and de-seasonal touristic offer, etc.



Summary

TOURIMPACT4BG aims to extend, update and adapt the conceptual and methodological model of CO-EVOLVE and its demonstration pilots in the Southern Adriatic (Italy-Albania-Montenegro). This proposal is presented in the frame of the Interreg IPA CBC Italy-Albania-Montenegro programme's priority on Tourism & Culture. The project focuses on the conditions for -and promotes- the co-evolution, as already addressed by CO-EVOLVE and Co-Evolve4BG, extending their action towards the Southern Adriatic area, and completing the framework of the MC4BG project. Similarly to CO-EVOLVE and Co-Evolve4BG, the analysis and the demonstration actions included in the project will produce results with a wide and long-lasting influence, fully exploiting the Blue Economy potential, promoting the creation of new markets and jobs in the field of ecosystem-oriented services (related to coastal and maritime tourism and coastal management & adaptation to climate change).
