Indications on training course (PAP/RAC)

In its Article 15, the **ICZM Protocol** recognizes the importance of awareness-raising activities on integrated coastal zone management, educational programmes, training, and public education at national, regional or local level

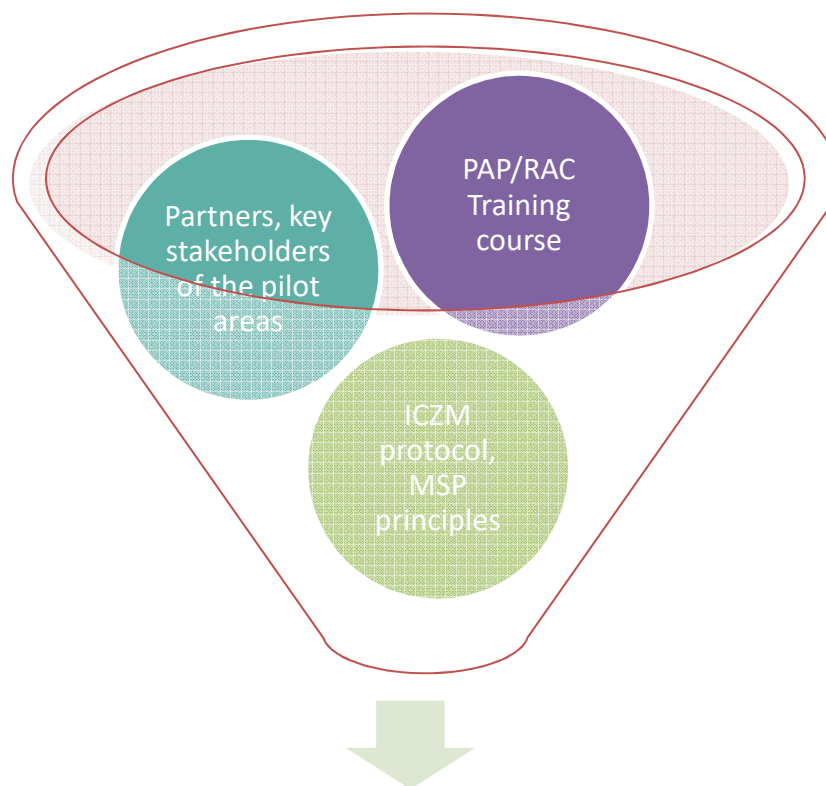
PAP/RAC will prepare the material for and organize the training courses in the framework of Co-Evolve, ensuring that the sustainable tourism planning in the pilot zones will be done in respect of the **ICZM Protocol's** provisions and of the **MSP principles**

The training courses are planned to be organized in March and September 2018.

The precise date and venues are to be agreed on during the Co-Evolve steering committees.



Indications on training course (PAP/RAC)



to get a common basis for a successful planning, leading to integrated decisions in sustainable tourism based on ICZM and MSP



Contents of training course (PAP/RAC)

The final structure and contents is adapted according to the findings and results of tasks **3.17 and 3.18**, as well as the first feedback from the Pilot Areas.

The **first training** course will be dedicated to a general introduction to the ICZM Process designed in the framework of Co-Evolve. The main training topics will include:

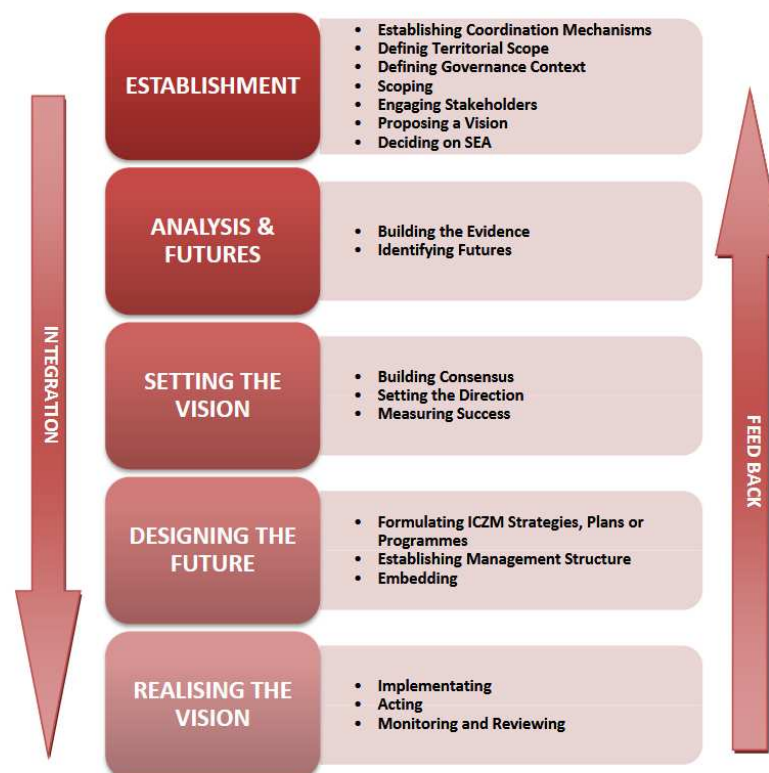
- Introduction to ICZM and MSP
- ICZM Process
- Tourism-driven strategic planning
- Involvement of stakeholders

The **second training** will highlight the major elements presented during the first training and will be more oriented towards the expressed needs of the pilot areas. A consultation on the specific needs of pilot project partners will be made prior to and during the 4th Steering Committee in order to fine-tune the course contents



Contents of training course (PAP/RAC)

The methodology designed for Co-Evolve will be adapted from the ICZM Process defined in the document “The ICZM Process, a roadmap towards coastal sustainability” available on the link <http://www.pap-thecoastcentre.org/pdfs/ICZM%20Process.pdf>, as well as from the Deliverable of 3.18.1 “Guideline for Tourism-driven strategic planning”.

Training courses

- number of participants
- number of Partners and other subjects represented
- satisfaction survey on the training courses
- training tools documentation



indicators of advancements /results for the different objects of the steps of monitoring are as follows:

Participatory process

- number of participants in the local seminars;
- number/identification of stakeholders/local actors represented;
- inputs/suggestions achieved for the local action plans;
- tools stimulating stakeholder interaction beyond the local seminars;
- progresses in the preparation of the local action plans;
- completion of the local action plans.



indicators of advancements /results for the different objects of the steps of monitoring are as follows:

Small Scale Investments

- advancements of administrative procedures, design, tenders, procurements; advancement of works, installations, etc.;
- intervention completion and related documentation.
