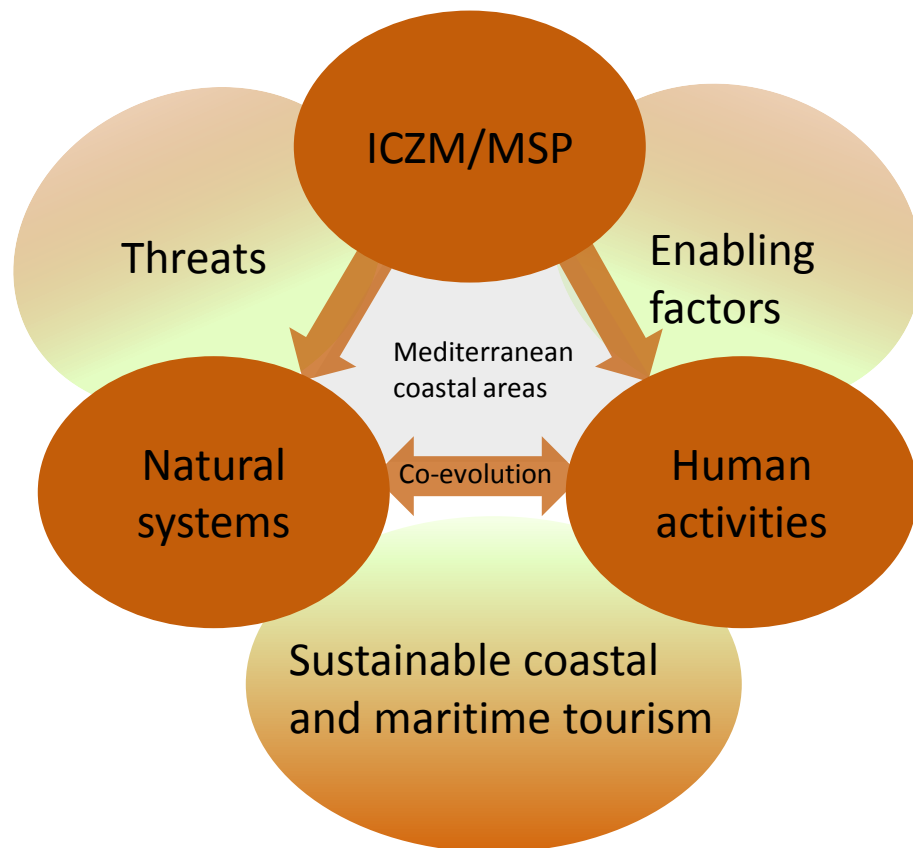

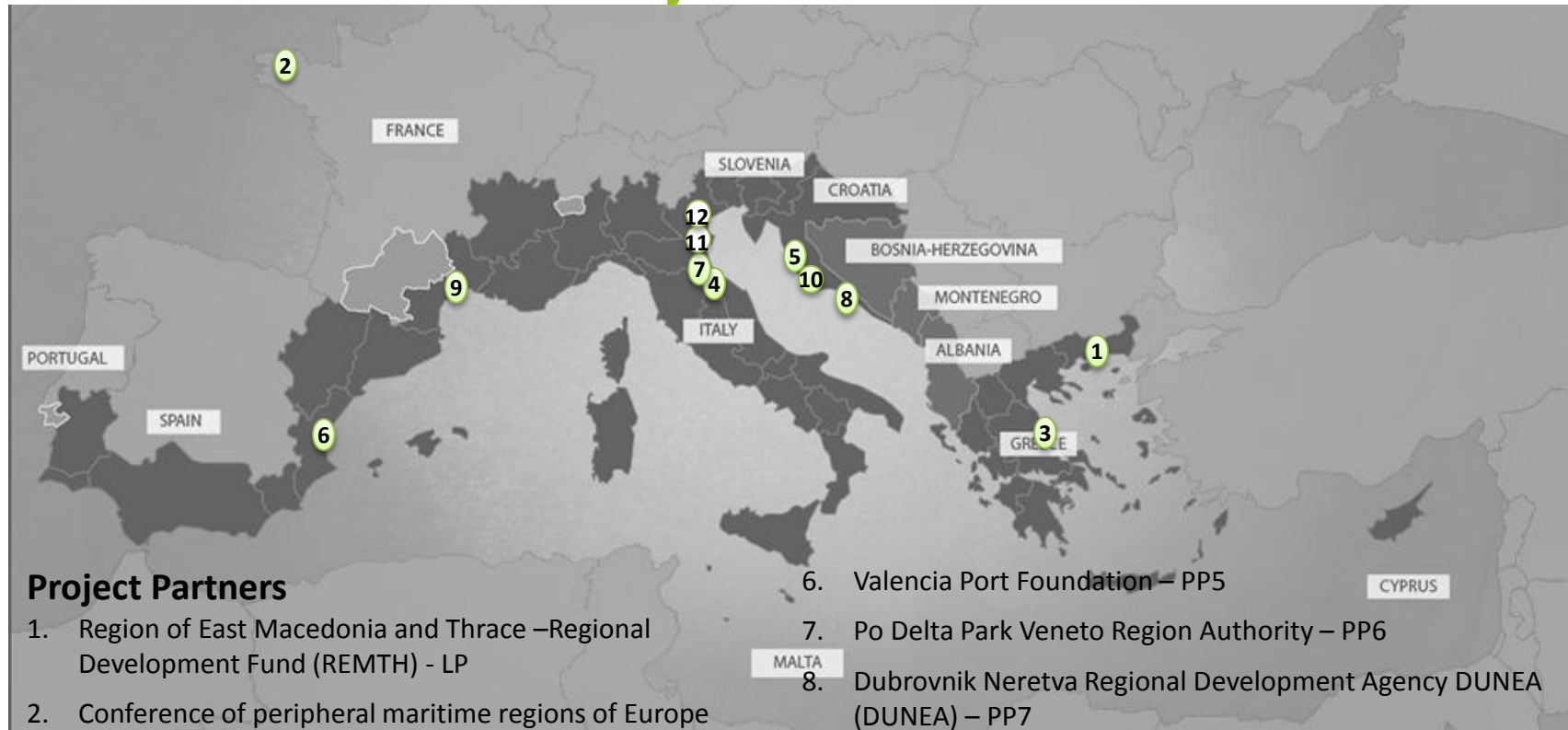


## II. Main outputs

- ICZM/MSP based action plans for sustainable tourism development in pilot areas and transferring actions at MED scale



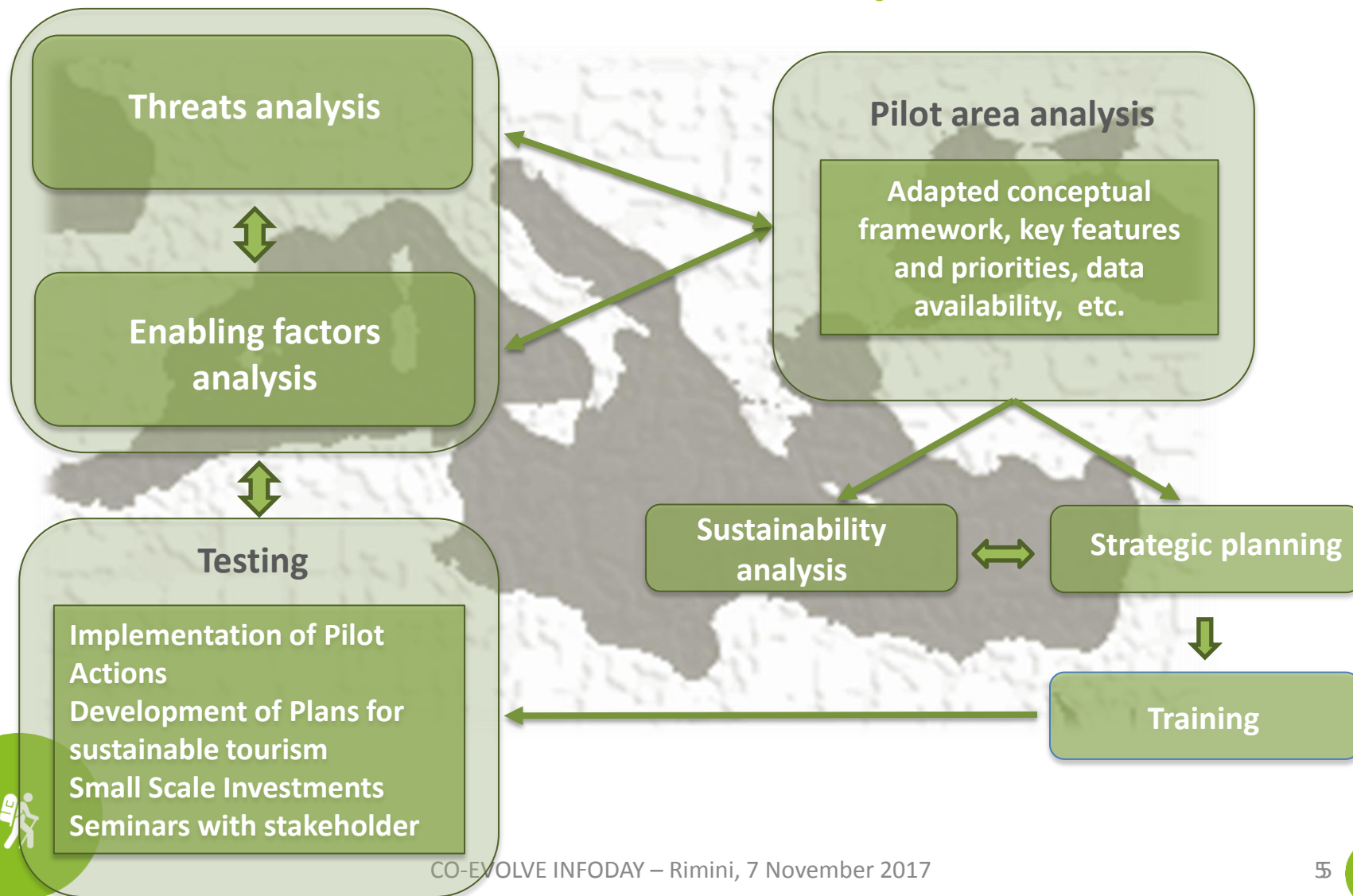

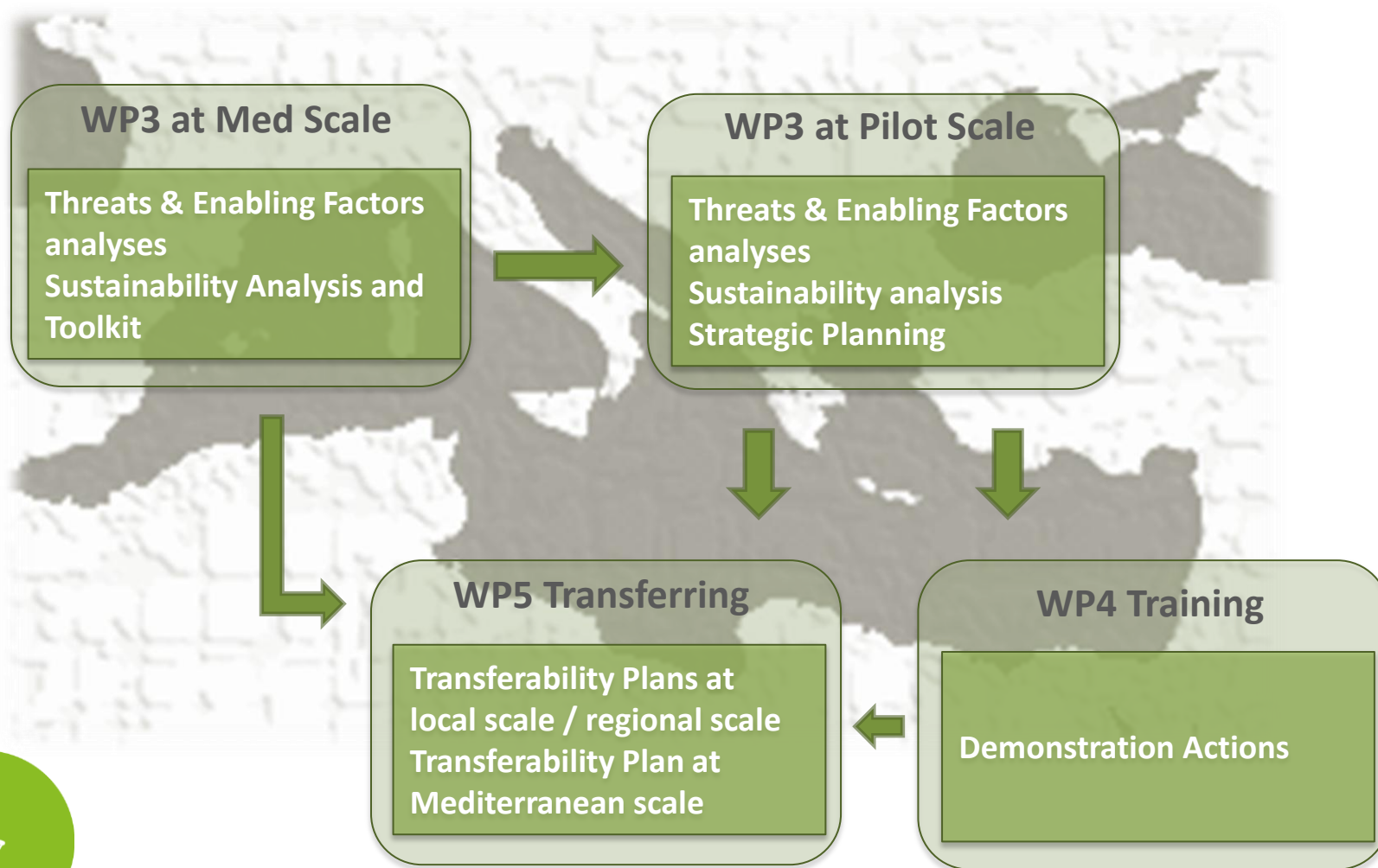

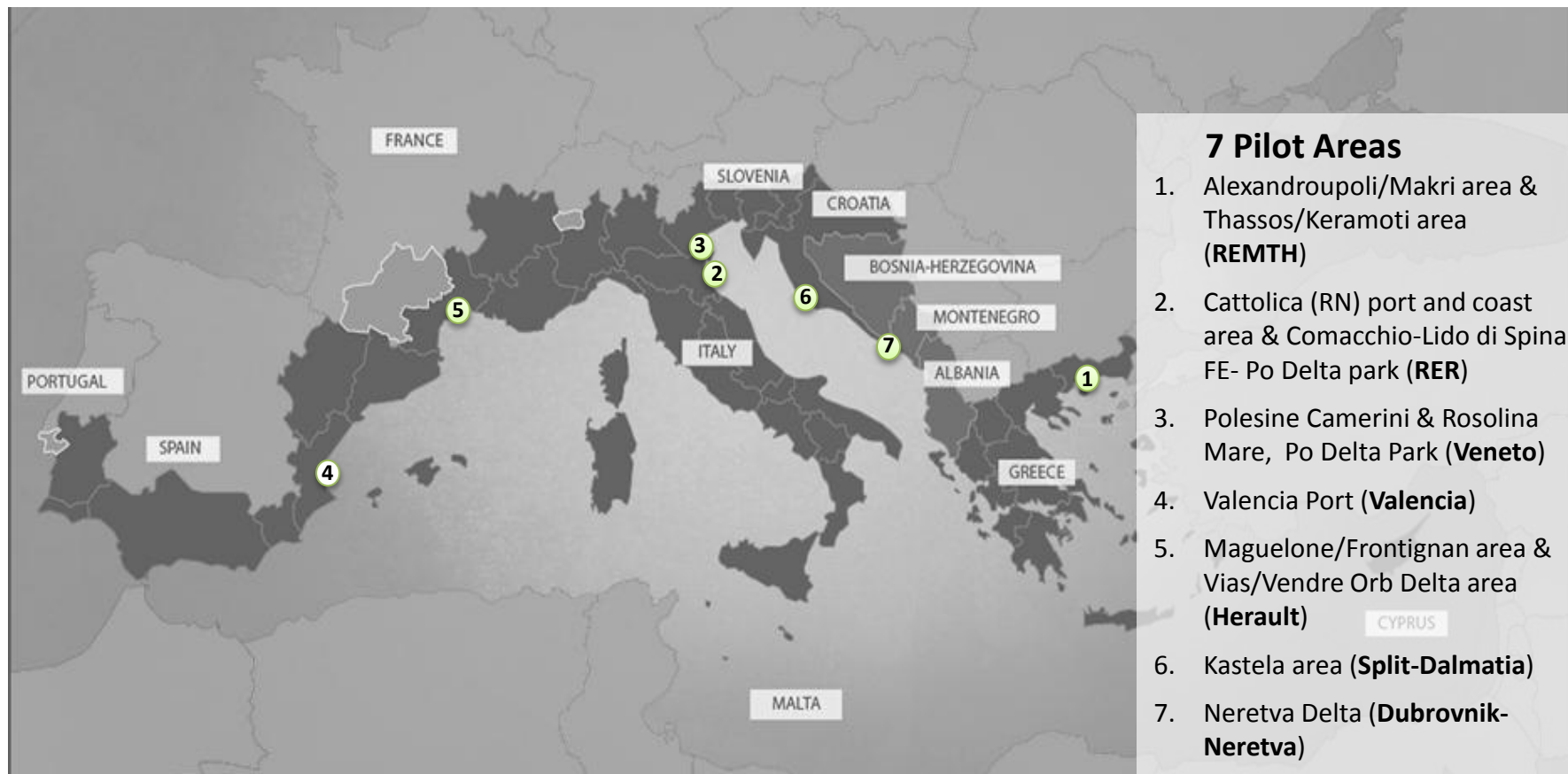

PA1 - Ensuring lasting sustainability of coastal and marine tourism development in REMTH  
(**REMTH**);

PA2 - Implementing regional ICZM guidelines principles for sustainable tourism & coastal management (**RER**); Cattolica harbor and coast area, Comacchio Lido di Spina/Logonovo area

PA3 - Planning Centre for Po-Delta area & demonstration on movable lodging prototypes  
(**DeltaPoVeneto**);

Polesine Camerini area, Rosolina Mare area

PA4 - Improve governance and facilitate mainstreaming into public action of the guiding principles set out in the ICZM Med Protocol (Valencia Port Foundation) Valencia port

PA5 - Experimental adaptation of planning and management of tourist fluxes in coastal areas subject to CC effects (**HERAULT**); Maguelone/Frontignan area, Vias/Vendre Orb Delta area
