








I. General Objective



CO-EVOLVE aims at analyzing and promoting the co-evolution of human activities and natural systems in touristic coastal areas, allowing sustainable development of touristic activities based on the principles of ICZM/MSP.













II. Main outputs

- Integrated analysis of threats and enabling factors for sustainable tourism at MED scale in order to:
 - Address policies at wide scale
 - Develop sustainable action plans and pilot actions
 - Develop transferability plans
- Sustainability analysis containing:
 - a conceptual model for assessing the level of sustainable development of tourism in the Mediterranean
 - Tourism Sustainability Toolkit to be applied at Mediterranean scale
- ICZM/MSP based action plans for sustainable tourism development in pilot areas and transferring actions at MED scale









VII. Pilot Actions

Activities: formulation of Plans on Pilot Areas + some Small Scale Investments:

- PA1 Ensuring lasting sustainability of coastal and marine tourism development in REMTH (**REMTH**);
 - Alexandroupoli/Makri area, Thassos/Keramoti area
- PA2 Implementing regional ICZM guidelines principles for sustainable tourism & coastal management (RER); Cattolica harbor and coast area, Comacchio Lido di Spina/Logonovo area
- PA3 Planning Centre for Po-Delta area & demonstration on movable lodging prototypes (**DeltaPoVeneto**);
 - Polesine Camerini area, Rosolina Mare area
- PA4 Improve governance and facilitate mainstreaming into public action of the guiding principles set out in the ICZM Med Protocol (Valencia Port Foundation) Valencia port
- PA5 Experimental adaptation of planning and management of tourist fluxes in coastal areas subject to CC effects (**HERAULT**); Maguelone/Frontignan area, Vias/Vendre Orb Delta area
- PA6 Valorisation of environmental & cultural heritage for a sustainable tourism-driven development in Kastela, Split-Dalmatia County (**RERA-SD**); Kastela area
- PA7 Implementation of integrated management plan of Neretva River Delta, Dubrovnik-Neretva County (**DUNEA**); Neretva River Delta
