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










II. Co-Evolve Tourism Destination Typology



- Average share of overnight stays at each destination against the total overnight stays in the Mediterranean destinations
- Average annual growth of overnight stays at each destination

- 1. high tourism dynamic
- 2. potential in tourism development
- 3. low prospects in tourism development

Mature destinations with

- high tourism dynamic
- 5. further potential in tourism
- 6. low prospects for further tourism development




