





IV. Observations so far and next steps

- Heterogeneity in tourism activities (beach/maritime, urban/cultural, cruising, recreational boating, ecotourism) and relevance of indicators to each PA
- Heterogeneity in data → Quantitative data ≠ Quality assessments
- Focus on what we need to measure **not** what we have available
- ➤ Focus on important data gaps → Should we proceed to **quality assessment**? Stakeholders involvement
- ➤ Elaboration and interpretation of data → Feeding 3.18 with short sustainability assessment analysis
