Promoting the **co-evolution** of **human activities** and **natural systems** for the development of sustainable coastal and maritime tourism



Objective: CO-EVOLVE aims at analysing and promoting the co-evolution of human activities and natural systems in touristic coastal areas, allowing sustainable development of touristic activities based on the principles of Integrated Coastal Zone Management (ICZM)/Maritime Spatial Planning (MSP).

3 main expected results of CO-EVOLVE project:

1. CO-EVOLVE will produce an analysis at Mediterranean scale of threats and enabling factors for sustainable tourism.



2. CO-EVOLVE will elaborate a conceptual model for assessing the level of sustainable development of tourism in the region and develop an operational Tourism Sustainability Toolkit to be applied at Mediterranean scale.



3. CO-EVOLVE will produce tourism-oriented strategic action plans and elaborate strategic planning proposals for each pilot area, including operative guidelines. A transferability plan at Mediterranean scale will also be produced.
