

**1. RADIO 1 - National radio broadcasting, VOCIDELMATTINO (Morning voices) -  
INTERVIEW Interview recorded by Colomba Sampalmieri - on air on 23 January 2017.**

Following an abstract with questions and answers:

The interview began with the introduction to the COMPOSE Project and its objectives: reducing energy consumption - in the fight against climate changes, but to reduce energy consumptions - through more energy efficiency and the transition to RES, while significantly contributing to the creation of new green jobs.

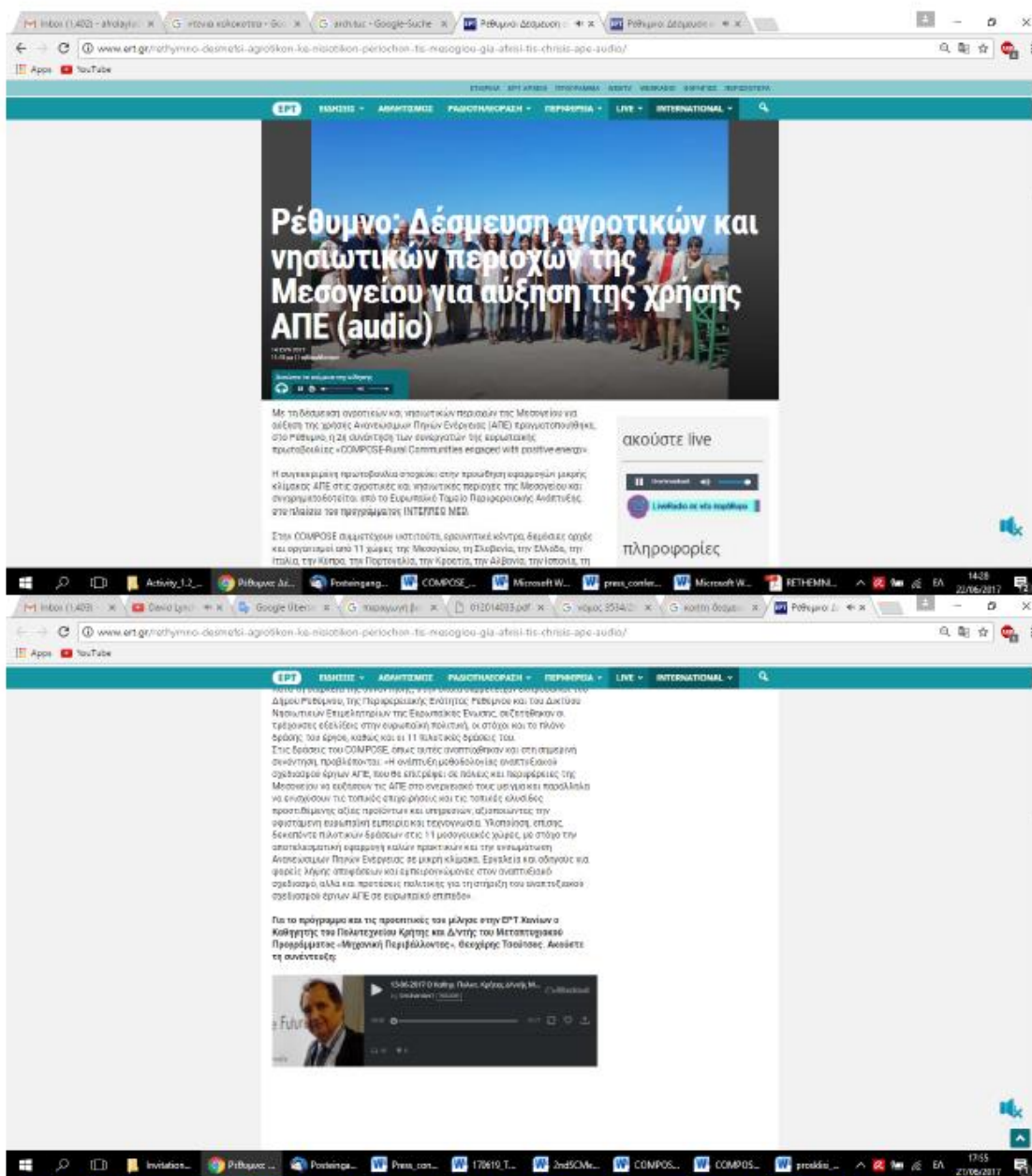
Questions 1 and 2 were about the chance for the EU to reach its goals at 2020 and at 2050: Prof. Lučka pointed out that while the average of the EU Member States have good chances to reach the agreed targets, there are still differences among Member States; she focused then, in addition to climate change challenges, on the importance of energy independence issues.

Question 3 asked whether the global context and awareness about modifications in climate has changed, after the Kyoto Protocol, the Paris COP21 Agreement and the Marrakech COP22 conclusions: it has changed a bit - Prof. Kajfež Bogataj answered, but what is more important is that governments and businessmen are starting to see the involvement against climate change as a business opportunity.

Question 4 was about the chance to have an economic growth while successfully fighting climate change: the most interesting opportunities, according to Prof. Kajfež Bogataj, are those connected to circular economy models: they allow the same development at the same time for the different countries, that share new technologies, recycle and produce in the same way. A new "winning" model, though, won't be possible without reducing the social inequalities.

Question 5 was related to the new USA Administration and its chances of modifying the announced climate change policy priorities: "Higher than 50% - Prof. Lučka replied - still President Trump is a businessman, and I hope he will see the business opportunities of the new "environmentally-friendly" technologies. I have faith also in his daughter Ivanka, who has such a different awareness about the climate change challenges: if, as I think, she will have an important role in the government, she won't let the US support for climate change agreements down".
