### MUNICIPALITY ZREČE AND SLOVENSKA BISTRICA, SLOVENIA

The purpose of pilot action is to ensure better efficiency of RES use in both municipalities. Based on local energy concepts with respect of natural, social and economic aspects, the project will contribute to the beneficiaries with: A feasibility study on development of a biomass logistic centre and (co-generation) district heating for the municipalities of Zreče and Slovenska Bistrica; (all together 3 documents: 1 feasibility study, 2 investment proposals for 2 biomass district heating); An economic calculation in combination with technical aspects of municipalities energy needs; A business model for a local biomass energy chain; Workshops and consultations with areas stakeholders, energy and development agencies and NATURA2000 representatives;
