### Short Description / Summary

The goal of the Transnational Workshop is to present the main results and lessons learnt of the Pilot Action. Further goal was to have an overall picture on the Pilot Actions of other cities and transnational best practices in sustainable commuting and to promote the cooperation and coordination between the municipalities and key stakeholders in the FUA related to transport planning.

In the panel discussion the participants expressed their positive reactions on the results of pilot action and welcomed their participation in developing smart commuting of Szolnok. The participants discussed the results and the recommendation of the pilot action (study) like:

- development of demand driven transport system:
  - o action area, line,
  - o functionality,
  - technological background and solution,
- implementation of alternatively powered vehicles:
  - results of analysis of different alternative technologies (CNG, LNG, hybrid, electric, hydrogen),
  - o recommended technology for Szolnok and its FUA electric busses,
  - o recommendation for bus renewal: 2 midi, 3 solo, 1 articulated bus,
  - o infrastructure requirements and recommended charging technology,
  - o recommendation for integration in the timetable (line),
- both topics:
  - o roadmap for implementation,
  - o cost of implementation,
  - effects on commuting in the aspects of sustainability.


