Topics and outcomes

"Energy Efficiency – a Good Beginning" was the title of the final conference indicating the end of ENERJ as the beginning of a new phase for energy efficiency in public buildings. After the presentation of the Interreg MED programme by Matoula Syropoulou from the Greek National Contact Point, Kostas Konstantinou, Project Manager of the Lead Partner Anatoliki S.A took the floor and illustrated the contribution of ENERJ to the challenge of energy efficiency in public buildings, while Vasilis Takavakoglu from Eleana Pana, Region of North Aegean which is a partner, presented the horizontal project MEDNICE and the added value of making the modular projects for energy efficiency in public buildings interact.

A most interesting case study, Fano urban climate regeneration plan, was presented by the architect Tiziana Gallo, Member of the National commission for the economic conversion of Taranto area at the Ministry for Economic Development, Rome, Italy. With a low cost procedure the project has created a database for public administrations and private actors to evaluate urban renewal measures with energy efficiency in buildings at the centre but also taking into account other factors, like urban green and mobility.

The two elements at the centre of ENERJ, Joint Actions and the database with energy data of public buildings were taken up in the next two presentations. Iakovos Sarigiannis, General Director of Anatoliki demonstrated the added value of forming an energy community for the three cities involved and Margherita Carè from the Metropolitan City of Rome Capital showed the functions and potentials of the ENERJ data platform. The latter is complementary to the SISMA tool, presented by Martin Murovec from GOLEA in the sense that the data obtained

Project co-financed by the European Regional Development Fund Projet cofinancé par le Fonds européen de développement regional from the ENERJ platform can be fed into the SISMA tool to simulate investment costs and payback time as a basis for producing for ESCOs attractive "packages" of buildings for energy retrofitting.

The conference gave an exhaustive overview of the achievements of ENERJ and at the same time shed light on the activities ENERJ has set in motion which will come to bear in the next months and years.

The final conference of ENERJ will be an occasion to discuss with the principal actors the results of the project and their relevance for the field of actions which is as difficult as it is important: energy efficiency in buildings, looking particularly at public buildings. The Mediterranean area is witnessing a fast growing energy demand, partly due to cooling needs which with climate change will only increase and a rapid urban development. If the Mediterranean wants to stay on track with implementing an inclusive and sustainable energy transition, energy efficiency in buildings, existing ones and new ones, will be a central issue.

Cities and Regions are key players in implementing energy efficiency policies in buildings, starting with their own ones and reaching out to the private sector. Most often the local course of energy transition has been laid down in a local energy plan, many of them in the framework of the Covenant of Mayors as a Sustainable Energy and Climate Action Plan (SEAP/SECAP). The conference will discuss the added value Joint Actions can produce and the role of Joint Actions Coordinators to bring together a group of actors in a specific territory.

The conference will have a pragmatic, application-oriented character. Highly skilled practitioners will present their experiences and discuss them with the audience. The conference is meant for public servants in local and regional administrations, energy experts and interested citizens. There will be simultaneous translation Greek-English.
