1. INTRODUCTION

The aim of this report is to record all the activities carried out by GRASPINNO partnership during the period February 2017 – September 2017, in order to provide input in the med web platform. These activities took place mainly after June 2017, when the web platform was released to the partners by Interreg MED Programme. Immediately after the activation of the web platform, GRASPINNO Communication Team, led by CCIT, started developing the content of the GRASPINNO web platform in the framework of the overall Interreg Med web platform. The GRASPINNO web platform will be supported by the Communication Team, respecting the Programme manual, guidelines and instructions.

For the 2014-2020 programming period, the Interreg MED Programme has adopted a new approach for project management that drives new orientation on project identities and on expected results rather than on processes or simple outputs.

The web platform is a tool defined to harmonize the projects presentations facilitating the interchange of information between projects, thematic communities and JTS

The web platform will constitute the communication and coordination hub of the whole Programme. It will be hosted on dedicated web servers, integrating the following:

- ✓ The Interreg MED Programme website;
- ✓ Specific thematic community websites, 8 thematic communities and Axis 4 website: blue growth, green growth, social and creative industries, efficient buildings, renewable energy, low carbon urban transports, sustainable tourism, biodiversity protection;
- ✓ Projects websites;
- ✓ Special Websites (for events)

2. PLAN

On March 2017, JTS of Interreg MED Programme disseminated to the web platform administrators the indicative planning for developing their web site. The time plan of the actions is presented below:

- Fulfilment of general sections, as for example, project's description and objectives.
- Uploading of GRASPINNO first newsletter and official brochure.
- News and events: latest news about 3rd Project Meeting, 3rd Steering Committee Meeting and 4th Technical Committee Meeting in Bastia has been uploaded.


4. INDIVIDUAL GRASPINNO WEBSITE

Even if not explicitly foreseen by MED Programme, for better promotion and dissemination of GRASPINNO project results and tools, a specific GRASPINNO website has been created at the following address: <http://www.graspinno.eu/>. Most precisely the main purpose of this website is not only to generally promote project's objectives, but rather to invite stakeholders to use the so called UNIFIED PLATFORM, that gained together three important tools, specifically created for helping those who are writing a public procurement to set up green energy requirements.

The website is composed by the following sections:

- About the project: partnership, background, objectives, and main expected results;
- Meeting and Events;
- Unified Platform;
- Newsletters;
- Contacts.

Except for the general sections (Project description, newsletter, contacts), that are common for most of project websites, the GRASPINNO website hosts the Unified Platform that deserves a specific description. Such platform indeed is composed by three tools: GRASPINNOdatabase, GRASPINNO e-GPP Support Tool and GRASPINNO LCC Calculating tool.



GRASPINNO database: A database architecture that strengthens the capacity of local/regional authorities to set quality green energy requirements, and of SMEs to propose solutions that implement these requirements;

GRASPINNO e-GPP Support Tool: Support for local authorities for collecting green specification that can be used for tender specification preparation.

GRASPINNO LCC Calculating tool: Life-Cycle costing calculating tool (Life-Cycle Costing is a methodology where costs of a given asset are considered throughout its life-cycle).

Enter to the platform is very easy, as it has been created for being used by public authorities and SMEs. It will be necessary only to register and later on enter your login username and password into the login mask.
