GRASPINNO PLUS aims to transfer key deliverables/outputs developed & tested at transnational level within GRASPINNO to new MED territories.

GRASPINNO Plus will capitalise the tools made available thanks to the GRASPINNO unified platform: GRASPINNO Database, eGPP support tool and LCC tool through. The consortium formed by 4 entities receivers and 2 givers (partners from GRASPINNO previous project)

THE CONSORTIUM

The consortium is composed by 6 partners from 4 countries (Greece, Italy, Montenegro and Spain). Four partners will be the receivers of the knowledge, methodology and tools to implement on their regions: Umbria Region (Italy), Chamber of Economy of Montenegro (Montenegro), Ilia Chamber (Greece) and Region of Western Greece (Greece). The givers are the Lead Partner, Terre di Siena Lab (Italy) and Chamber of Commerce of Terrassa (Spain).

GRASPINNO PLUS OVERALL RESULTS

In the design phase, GRASPINNO PLUS identified as expected results an increase in awareness, greater / stronger skills and better capacities of regional/local government and networks/clusters of SMEs aimed to implement a more circular economy and sustainable growth through transnational cooperation.

The use of project-specific tools such as Data-Base, eGPP support tool, and a tool for calculating life cycle costs - LCC (Unified Platform Package) has been disseminated in all receivers regions.

Finally, the project identified 2 main outputs: two Memoranda of Understanding (one for companies and the other one for Public Administrations) and specific transfer seminars for local stakeholders (mainly enterprises).

MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

GRASPINNO PLUS promotes good practices on green public procurement, supporting Public Authorities and Small and Medium enterprises. To consolidate the intentions for the adoption of GRASPINNO methodology, stakeholders from all partner countries are invited to sign a Memorandum of Understanding specially defined for each kind of them.

Until now, 30 Public Authorities and 31 SMEs signed the Memorandum of Understanding expressing their commitment to adopt GRASPINNO guidelines and tools, and for uptake and replication actions in the field of green public procurement.
