GRASPINNO

Transnational model, strategies and decision support for innovative
clusters and business networks towards green growth, focusing on
green e-procurement in EE/RES for energy refurbishment of public
buildings

project

GRASPINNO is a project co-funded by the European Union through the Interreg MED programme 2014-2020 in the framework of the first call proposal for modular projects, priority axis 1.1. The project, started on November 2016, aims at increasing transnational activities of innovative clusters and networks of key sectors of MED area under the Community of Green Growth.

The GRASPINNO Consortium is composed by 12 partners coming from 7 Mediterranean Countries (Greece, Italy, Slovenia, Cyprus, Spain, Bosnia Herzegovina and France). The project means to provide innovative green procurement solutions for energy savings/efficient refurbishment of public buildings, focusing on smart cities and communities. Project's main goals are to improve Public Authorities (PAs) capacity of managing buildings energy efficiency, moving towards nearly zero energy building and to encourage SMEs to enter the green energy market.

activities

The project will:

- Lead to the creation of a platform for supporting public administrations in the management of electronic Green Public Procurement eGPP, integrating and standardising already existing tools;
- Test this platform through 10 pilot actions to be developed in different geographical areas. Pilots will help public administrations to define best energy solutions for the refurbishment of public buildings, to plan green call for tenders by means of such eGPP platform and to publish and award call for tenders according to rules of each Countries.
- Transfer project's results in all GRASPINNO countries and MED area through specific trainings. Realize a road map for a large-scale platform utilization promotion;
- Organize Living Lab for transferring information to local stakeholders, in particular to Municipalities for the realization Sustainable Energy Action Plan (SEAP).

opportunities

New changes given by the project:

- Creation of an ecosystem of SMEs specialised in the supply of components and systems for buildings refurbishment, able to participate to call for tenders opened by national and international Public Administrations;
- Improvement of Public authorities capacities to issue Green Procurement policies in order to increase their competencies on public buildings energy refurbishment, according to local, regional and national legislation.
- Valorisation of international best practices, coming from GRASPINNO partners, in the framework of public buildings energy refurbishment at Mediterranean level.
