WE ARE MED GOING BEYOND THEMATIC COMMUNITITES

The event, took place in Alicante, Museo de la Universidad de Alicante, on the 17th May 2017, aimed to match together the eight thematic communities cofinanced by the MED Programme: Blue Growth, Green Growth, Social 6 Creative, Efficient Buildings, Renewable Energy, Urban Transport, Sustainable Tourism and Biodiversity Protection



MAESTRALE aims to lay the foundations for a Blue Growth strategy in the Mediterranean area. Almost 90% of the world's maritime renewable energy is produced in Europe, but there is a need for better understanding of the legislative and technological context for promoting investments and operating plants. PPs will cooperate to identify renewable energy potential and possible barriers, also supporting in the preparation of pilot projects on Blue Energy plants.

PELAGOS aims to develop smart and sustainable growth by enhancing a transnational MED Cluster in the Blue Energy sector and by facilitating the distribution of targeted solutions and products specifically calibrated for the Mediterranean region.

PROteus aims at exploting the growth potential of the emrging Maritime Surveillance industry in the MED area. The establishement of a MED MS Cluster will foster the eachievement of this goal.

The event was the first opportunity for the blue growth community projects to meet each other and create synergies.

WE ARE MED - GOING BEYOND THEMATIC COMMUNITIES

On 17th May in Alicante, the Interreg MED Programme organised a community building event entitled for working together on a common work methodology and building a strong Interreg MED community. All the thematic communities with their projects and partners were invited.

The Interreg MED Programme is committed to induce synergies and transversal debates between thematic projects, right from the start by creating a joint work dynamic and a sense of belonging to the Interreg MED community of stakeholders.
