
Pilot actions preparation - development of the indicators system, methodologies and tools (indicators list, GAP analysis, guidelines open platform...)

Initial steps:

- Information gathering
- Thresholds

For each indicator the following issues have been investigated:

- Data Issues
- Adaptation to Coastal and Maritime areas
- Comparability and transferability
- Issues with the goal and definition of the indicator
- Problems derived from the indicator basis
- Data collection system (s)








Pilot 2 "Green beaches" (Cyprus green beaches, blue flags programme, ISO 13009:2015: Tourism and related services, Green Destinations Standard, Quality coast award, Q for quality award, Costa Nostrum, Spiaggia libera tutti, eco sustainable beach requirements...)

"Green beach" Standard: debate around the broad categories, related to various aspects of sustainable development, that can be applied to any recreational beach.

- ✓ Quality of bathing waters
- ✓ Quality of the beach
- √Safety
- ✓ Accessibility to all
- ✓ Eco-sustainable furnishings
- ✓ Sustainable transport
- ✓ Management
