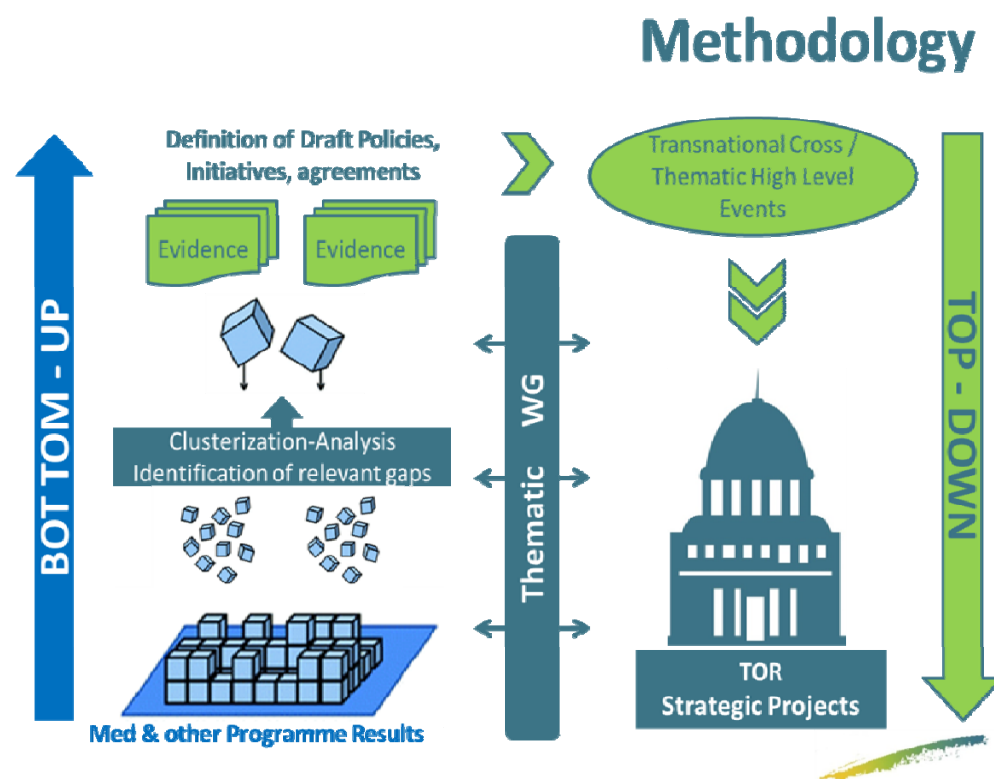

Overall Goal of “PANORAMED”

- *Obj #1:* to promote the creation of a permanent forum of subjects – public institutions, international organizations, research institutions, stakeholders – to contribute to the debate on the most relevant issues for the Mediterranean, from a governance point of view, and to identify shared tools to improve policies, with specific reference to coastal and maritime tourism, maritime surveillance and innovation; (supported by WP 7 Liaising)
- *Obj #2:* to promote strategic and qualified projects and partnerships in the two priority themes currently under analysis and investigation (coastal and maritime tourism and maritime surveillance). The above mentioned objectives are strictly linked one other and the strategic projects to be funded in the framework of the Axis 4 of the INTERREG (supported by Thematic Workings Groups, and Working Group on Terms of References)

PANORAMED Structure



- With a total of 19 partners, PANORAMED is composed by Ministries and Regions coming from 12 participating States of the MED Programme (**LEADER PARTNER: Ministry of Finances and Public Administration-Spain**)
- Works as a platform of National and Regional authorities, through transnational Thematic Working Groups (TWG), involving strategic key actors,
- Identifies shared policy approaches and strategic top down projects.

PANORAMED Cross Cutting Thematic Tasks

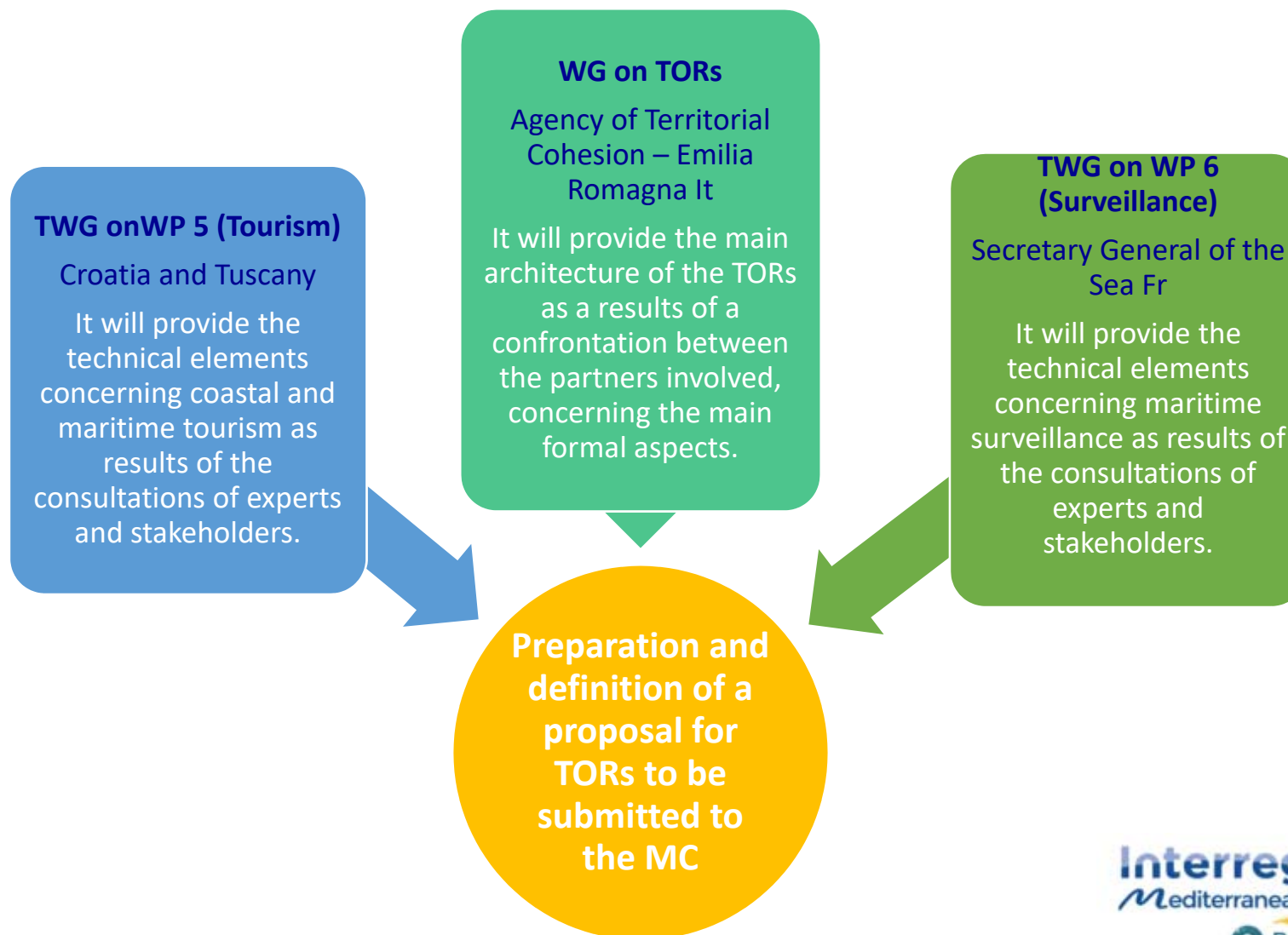
Coastal and Maritime Tourism:

- Of high importance for security plans and safe living, working, and leisure.

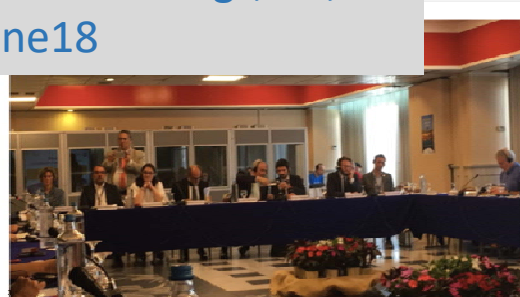

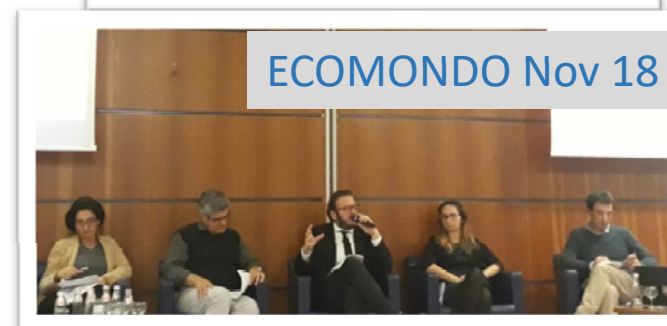
