

The MOTIVATE e-platform is ON AIR!!

We are happy to announce the official launch of the MOTIVATE e-platform, core output of the MOTIVATE project!

A cloud-based service that collects raw data and provides a first-level overview of daily trips and citizens' opinions, the MOTIVATE platform will offer a very useful tool for sustainable mobility planning in Almada, Ioannina, Larnaca, Siena and Rhodes.

The platform can be used from various sources, i.e. web browsers and mobile devices like smartphones and tablets, both iOS and Android.

Main features include:

- Trip Diaries, where end users record their daily trips
- **Measures Evaluation**, where end users evaluate existing measures and transport services of their city
- **Future Intervention Assessment**, where end users share their views regarding possible sustainable mobility interventions in their city
- Game, where end users perform actions and assess their impact in a virtual urban environment, thus becoming familiar with the notion of sustainable mobility

The MOTIVATE e-platform is a great tool for developing SUMPs in a participatory and inclusive way!

- Streamline the project outcomes in the policy and decision-making process of each city
- Reinforce multi-level and multi-lateral governance and strengthen collaboration between the private and public sector

GO-SUMP Meeting in Torres Vedras

GO-SUMP, gathered in Torres Vedras, Portugal, at the end of September, for the second community building event. All six modular projects of the Low Carbon Economy and Urban Transports community were present, namely CAMPSUMP, LOCATIONS, MOBILITAS, MOTIVATE, REMEDIO and SUMPORT!
