The MPA-ADAPT's goals are to develop collaborative and site-specific adaptation plans for Marine Protected Areas (MPAs) to enhance their resilience to climate change impacts. It also aims to incorporate vulnerability assessments and nature-based adaptation planning into their existing management framework, and provide guidance to implement and test climate-change management approaches.

This project is a first of its kind for the marine and coastal Mediterranean environment and will also foster networks by improving the dialogue and coordination between MPA managers and scientists in order to create the first line of Mediterranean MPA sentinel sites.
