ODEON: Open Data for European Open iNnovation

Ready for implement pilot actions!

ODEON project aims at the support of the growth of Clusters and SMEs, linked to Strategies for Smart Specialisation (S3) of the areas involved (focusing on Green/Blue growth and Cultural and Creative Industries) through the exploitation of Open and Linked Open Data.

In seven (7) Mediterranean Countries, each of different characteristics, a Data Hub will be created and it will participate actively in the formation of a Med Open Data Cluster of seven Data Hubs.

These Data Hubs will develop a network of SMEs, Public Institutions and the rest of the Private Sector so that they can offer tailored support for the exploitation of Open Data.

Furthermore, these Hubs will address to the needs of their members by providing services, tools and methodologies and will also enable them to create innovation products and services.

These seven Data Hubs will be created in the following countries:

- Italy
- Slovenia
- Spain
- Greece
- Montenegro
- Croatia
- France

And will become part of the ODEON MED DATA CLUSTER

BARCELONA – SPAIN

Partners met in Barcelona to discuss the state of art of the project. For the first time the representatives of the associated partners participated in the advisory committee meeting to comment and validate the methodology and evaluate the progress of the pilot activities.

Partners had the opportunity to listen to some experts invited by KIM BCN with the objective of presenting the actual situation of Spain, in particular Catalonia and Barcelona regarding open data, the legal framework and the methodologies used for creation of new business models, discussing about the importance of the value of data, as well as what are the current trends and their evolution in the management of open data portals and how they impact. In particular Eli Vivas, journalist specializing in Open Data and co-founder of StoryData, presented some use cases of open data for journalism and reporting. She demonstrated some examples of how to create a business model based on the value of Open Data by offering global communication services to starting from a set of data and serving as a link between Open Data portals, the media and citizens.

A great emphasis has been placed on the potential of data and the different ways in which they can be used. After the presentation, the partners were invited for a tour at 22@.
