#### PUBLIC SUPPORT MECHANISMS



FIRECE project is presenting the following financial mechanisms that are provided by public operators or by private operators with involvement of public financial sources:

- Financial instruments provided in combination with ERDF funding (operated by Operation Programs operators)
- Financial instruments provided by national or regional development banks
- Financial instruments provided by international financial institutions (through national commercial banks)-credit lines



#### **ERDF FUNDING**



ERDF (European Regional Development Fund) is one of the European Structural and Investment Funds that provides funding through national and regional Operational Programmes

It provides funding mostly in a form of grants; however, the intention of the European Commission is to provide the ERDF funding more through financial instruments which will enable to support a wider range of projects as the financial sources will be used repeatedly

All about ERDF funding and its combination with financial instruments is presented in module 3.3.



### **ENERGY PERFORMANCE CONTRACTING (EPC)**



EPC encompasses development, performance and financing of projects to improve energy efficiency carried out by Energy Service Companies (ESCO).

EPC financing can be efficiently combined with ERDF funding:

- Part of the project is funded from ERDF, the rest is covered by EPC financing
- In some Operational Programmes, project that combine ERDF and EPC can get extra points in the evaluation process

Detailed information about EPC is presented in module 3.4.



#### NATIONAL DEVELOPMENT BANKS



National development banks are financial institution, created by a country's government, that provide financing for the purposes of economic development of the country - which may include also energy-related financing programs.

Similarly to national public funds, their programs usually complement the ERDF funding; however at the same time, they make use of the benefits of financial instruments.



# CREDIT LINES OF INTERNATIONAL FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS



The credit lines are financial means provided by the International Financial Institutions (e.g. EBRD, EIB) through the local Participating Banks to finance resource efficiency, energy efficiency and renewable energy investment opportunities.

The credit line is usually supported by a comprehensive technical assistance package that underpins the demand for the financial facility, helps the borrowers to prepare loan applications and educate local bank officers in sustainable energy investment opportunities, credit appraisal methods and improving the investment climate.



# FINANCIAL MECHANISMS AVAILABLE IN THE PROJECT PARTNERS REGIONS



The financial mechanisms in the project partners regions include funding in a form of grants (usually from ERDF) and financial mechanisms (often soft loans).

The financial mechanisms are analyzed from different point of view, including:

- types of mechanisms
- types of measures that can be financed
- evaluation process



# FINANCIAL MECHANISMS AVAILABLE IN THE PROJECT PARTNERS REGIONS



### Financing situation in EU Member States

New Member States (EU-13)

The regions from the EU-13 mostly rely on grants distributed from ERDF via Operational Programs (e.g. Poland, Hungary, Czech Republic)

Old Member States (EU-15)

Funds are available from national or regional sources and commonly are provided in a form of financial instruments, such as soft loans or revolving funds (e.g. Austria, Italy, Germany)

The budget available from **ERDF/OPs** still prevails in the EU Member States



# TYPES OF FINANCIAL MECHANISMS IN THE PROJECT PARTNER REGIONS








### PROPORTION BETWEEN FUNDING MECHANISMS Interreg AND FINANCIAL INSTRUMENTS








#### TYPES OF FUNDING MECHANISMS





Majority of funding mechanisms (grants) are implemented in a form of ERDF Operational Programs.

About 1/3 is provided from national or regional budgets.



# SUPPORT ON IMPLEMENTATION AND REALIZATION OF MEASURES



#### Investment measures

The measures of investment nature are primarily subsidized, which includes measures to introduce a more efficient equipment, installation of efficient lighting, installation of renewable energy sources, etc.

#### "Soft" measures

The measures for "soft" projects, such as elaboration of energy audit, implementation of energy management, introduction of energy management system, etc. are supported indirectly by certain programs that require them as an integral part of the overall project realization.



Additional info: The entrepreneurs have a ten-year maturity with the option of postponing principal repayments for up to 4 years. In order to obtain a preferential loan, a company simultaneously have to take a commercial loan from one of the cooperating financial institutions, at a minimum of 20% of eligible project expenditure.

In addition to this form of support, entrepreneurs can also get an interest rate subsidy on a commercial loan, up to CZK 1.5 million, and a financial contribution to purchase an energy audit, up to CZK 250 thousand.

Additional info: The programme is funded from the proceeds of the sale of emission allowances for 2014. The support is provided in the form of a non-interest-bearing investment loan up to 70 % of the eligible expenditure (i.e. in the CZK 2-20 million range), with a maturity of ten years. At the same time, the beneficiary can receive a financial contribution for the purchase of an energy assessment up to CZK 100 000 ( $\sim$  4 000). In the case of energy savings, according to the project plan, within three years of the completion of the project, the entrepreneur will also receive a bonus financial contribution of 7 % of the exhausted amount of the preferential loan.
