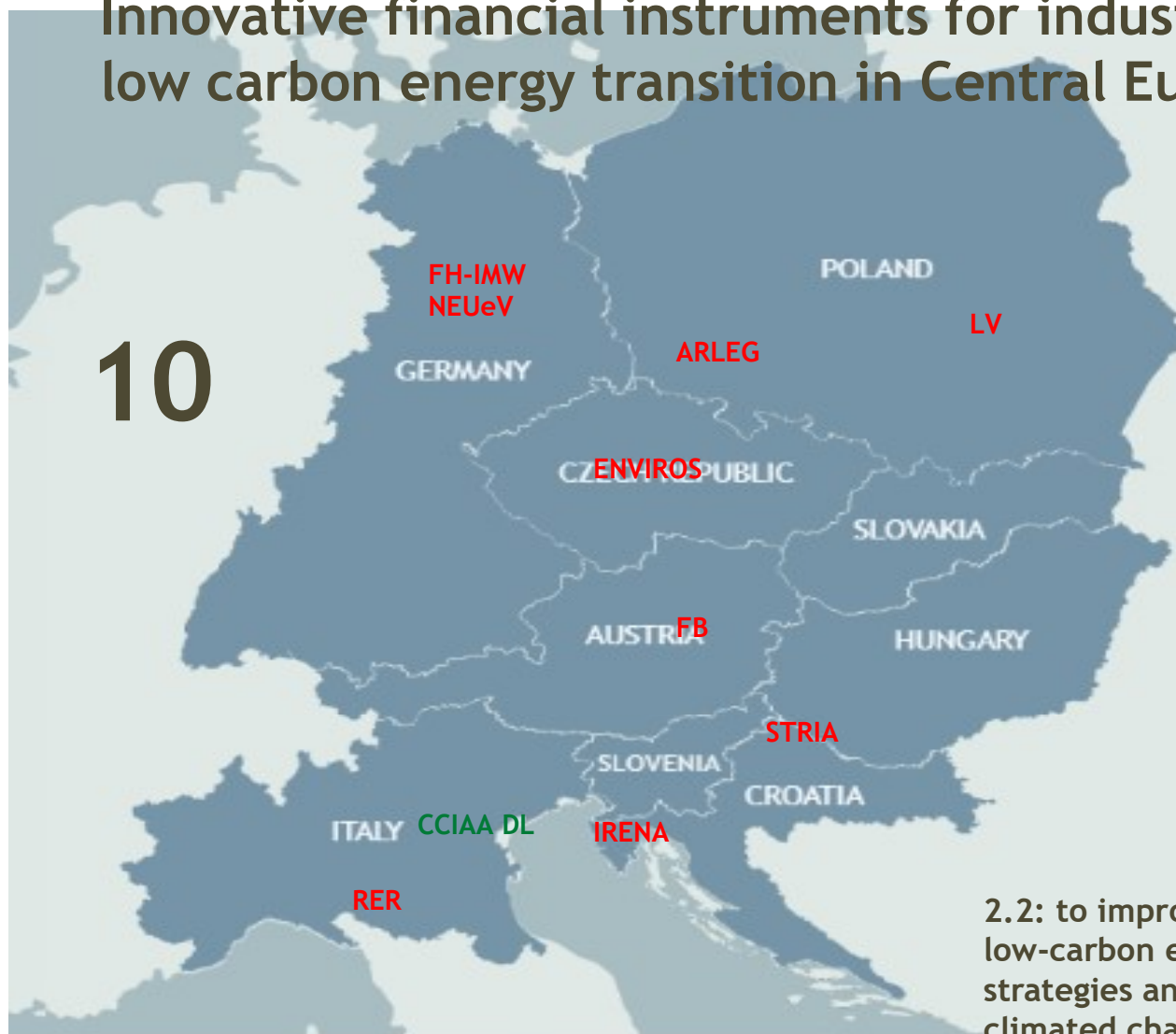

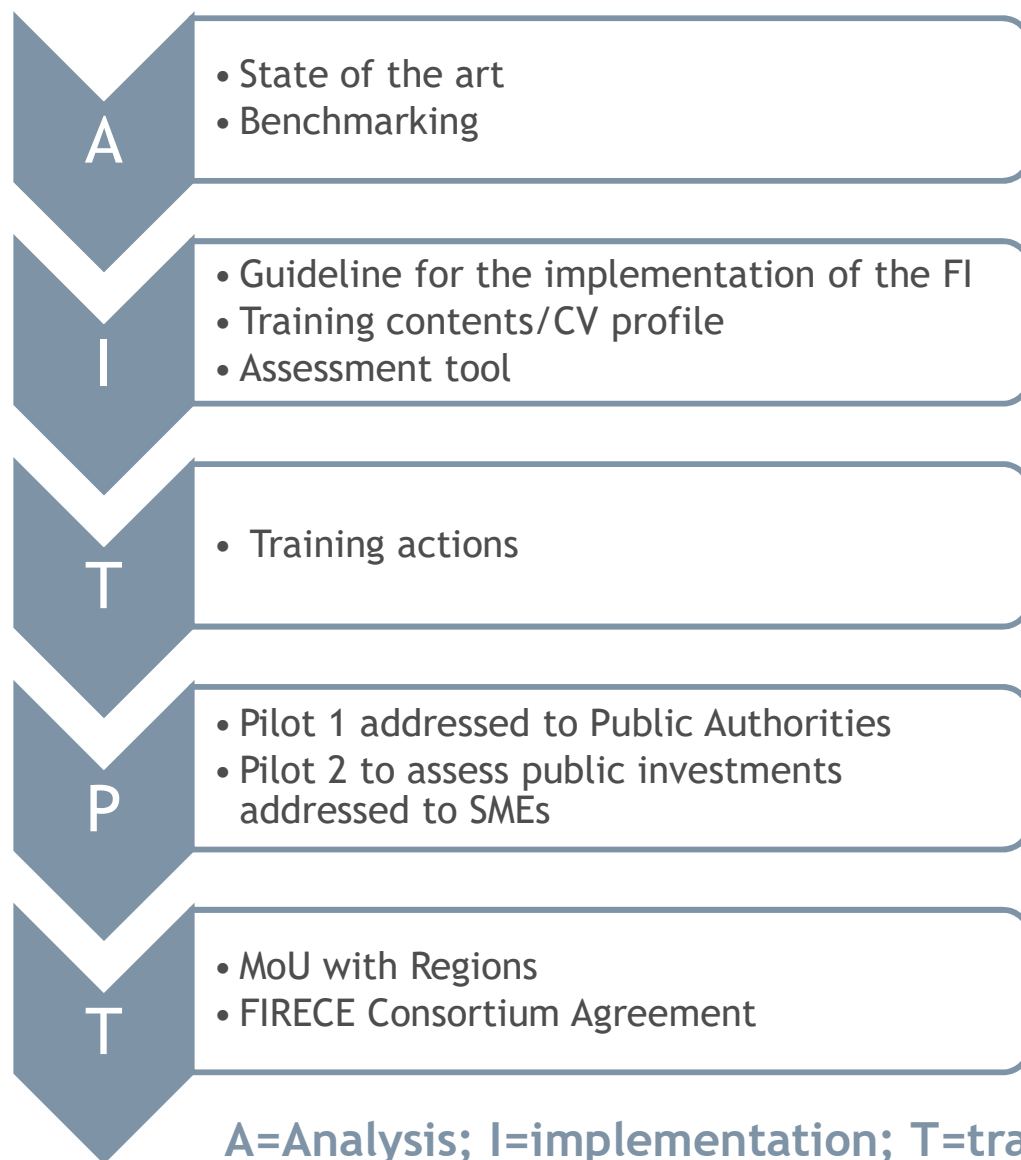

# PROJECT MAIN STRUCTURE



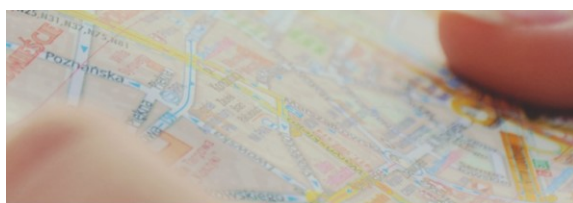

Fi-compass is a unique platform for advisory services on financial instruments under the European Structural and Investment Funds (ESIF) and microfinance under the Programme for Employment and Social Innovation (ERDF).

Fi-compass is provided by the European Commission in partnership with the European Investment Bank.

Fi-compass is designed to support ESIF managing authorities, ESIF microfinance providers and other interested parties, by providing practical know-how and learning tools on financial instruments. These will include "how-to" manuals, factbooks for quick reference, e-learning modules, face-to-face training seminars and networking events.

The Fi-compass website will progressively become the knowledge hub for ESIF financial instruments.
