- Metropolitan Area of Styria, Graz and surroundings (Austria)
- Area: 52 municipalities covering about 1.900 km²
- Inhabitants: 481.000
- Population density: Average population density of 254 inhabitants per km², varies from 20 inhabitants per km² in very rural areas to 600 inhabitants per km² ins (sub)-urban municipalities in the south of Graz

Organisational profile:

- Sectoral agency for integrated regional development with a sustainable projectand network management in the field of mobility as one of the main competences;
- Assistance projects from strategy to implementation on mobility-management and financing of public transport.

Role in the project:

Activities in the project:
