
Our perception of sustainable mobility

It includes all means of transport and mobility:


- From cycling and walking

- EU-funded projects: DESTINATIONS (Rethymno, Limassol), SUITS (Kalamaria), SUMPs UP, SATELLITE



CIVINET CY-EL: How we got there

- Advocacy strategy for sustainable mobility on islands at national level: earmarking of 9,5M EUROS for 162 municipalities for SUMP elaboration
- Development of Sustainable Island Mobility Plan (SIMP) tool, tailoring SUMP for the islands
 - ✓ Promotion at EU level: ECOMM and CIVITAS Forum (2017)
- Support of local authorities for participating in EU-funded programmes
- Registration of 36 municipalities to CIVITAS Network (+10%)






