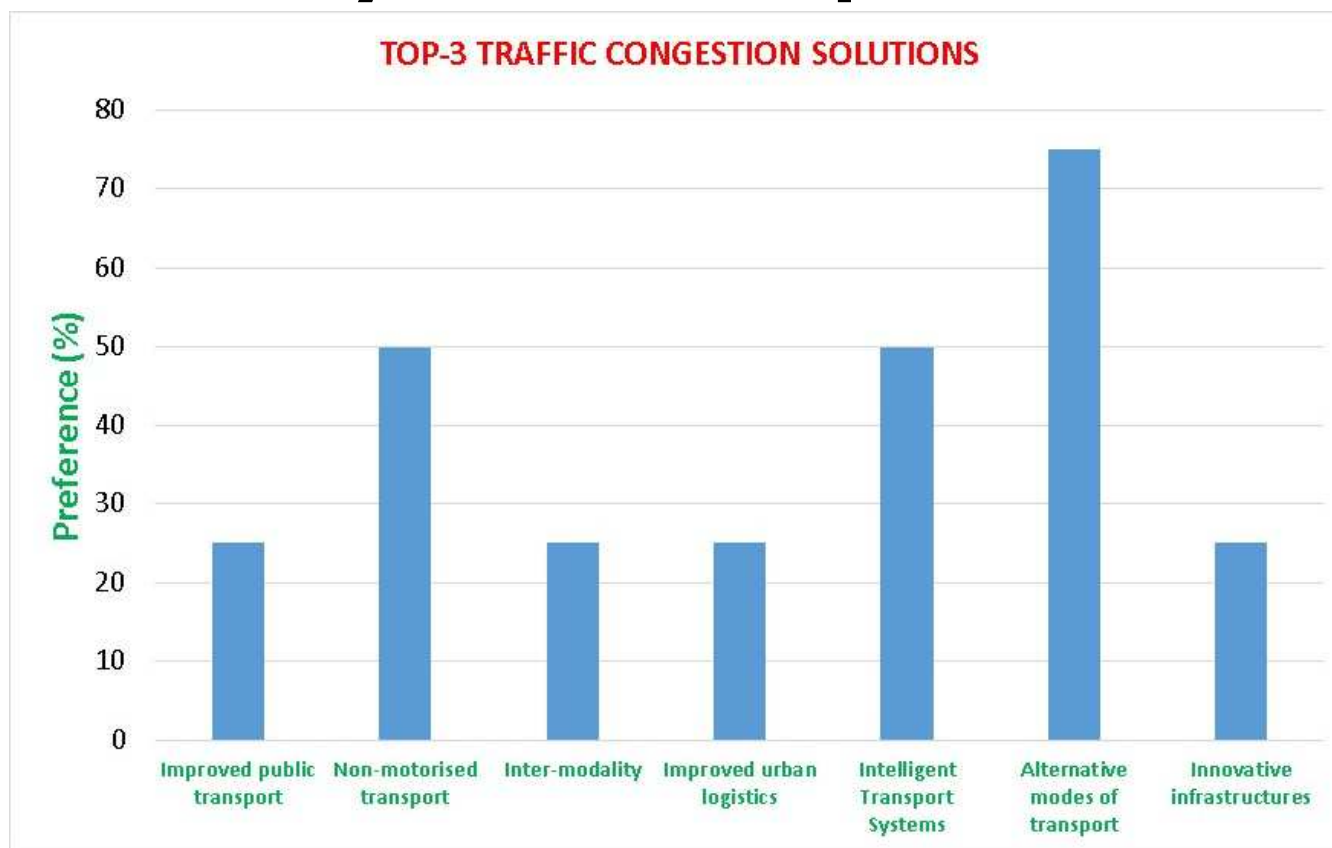

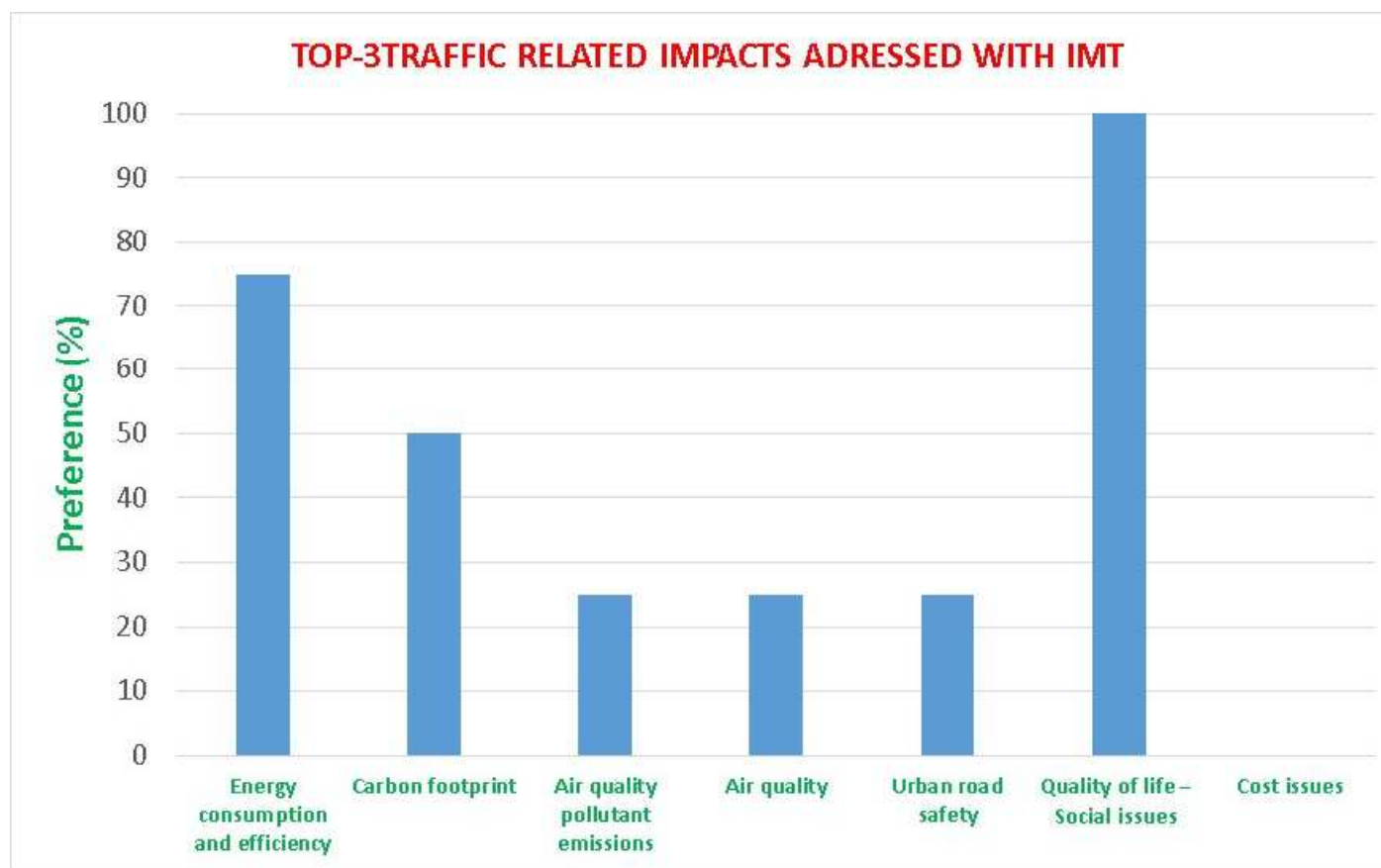
Transferability Activities
