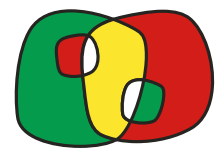

# GOALS

The **Integr@tención** project aims at developing products and services for an autonomous life, resulting from R&D&i activities in cross-border areas, to ensure that elderly people with dependency, disability or chronic disease can be treated at home until end of life, if that is their wish.

The goals will be achieved through the development and piloting of a joint model of attention and technology progress, which coordinates and aligns the chain of provision of proximity care and the design and deployment of innovative solutions, with the expectations, wishes and decisions of the person or end user.



Integr@tención has been awarded “3 Stars” Reference Site of the European Innovation Partnership on Active and Healthy Ageing (EIP on AHA)

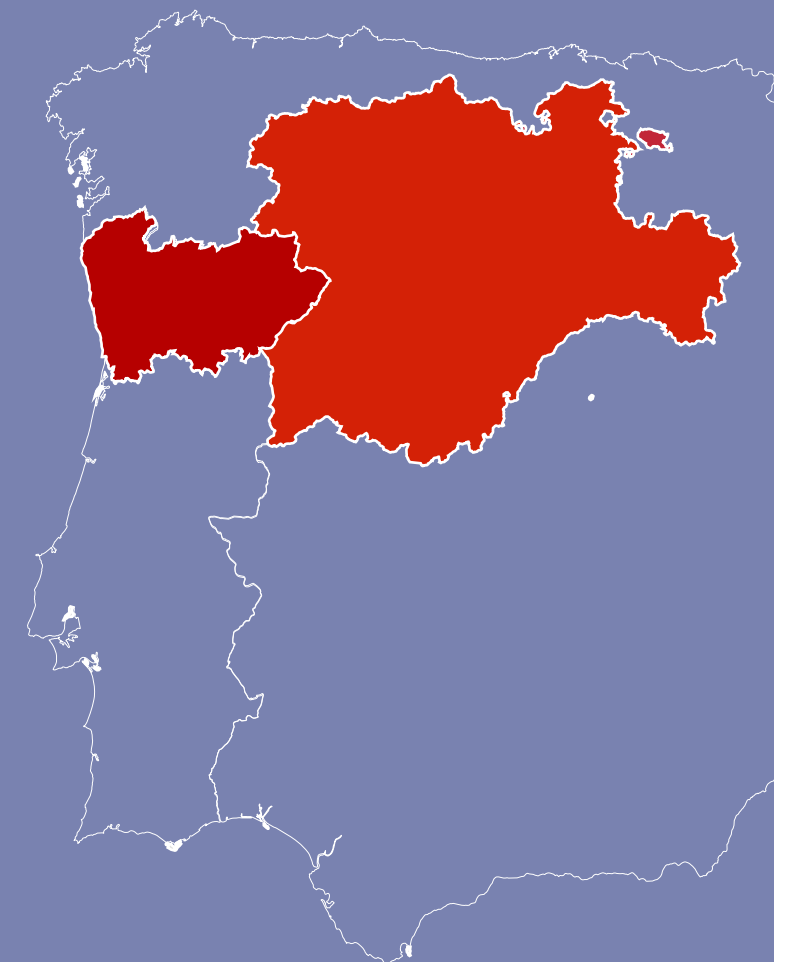

## OUTCOME

- Consolidation of the platform to increase innovative solutions in social and home health care in the cross-border region of northern Portugal and Castile and León.
- Creation of an Impact Hub dedicated to the commercialisation facility, generation of competitive advantage and social impact of Integr@tención's innovative solutions in the target territory and sector, through a commercialisation acceleration services program.



In the project, ten technologies will be adapted to the expectations of the users and the requirements of the Integr@tención model, from which three will benefit from the pilot action of escalation, go-to-market bonds and a patentability study.



INTRAS is a non-profit organization dedicated to provide health and social-health care in mental health and ageing, as well as to carry out research and innovation projects in these domains. INTRAS manages a network of 11 centers, 4 community support teams and 60 community apartments in 8 provinces in Spain, involving over 200 professionals and serving yearly more than 1.000 users.



Autonomous administrative body, supervised by the Council of Family and Equal Opportunities of the Board of Castilla y León (Spain). Servicios Sociales is the regional public authority responsible for the design, planning and management of social services in the region.

The Health Cluster Portugal (HCP) is a private non-profit association. Together, HCP and its members develop innovative projects in areas such as translational and clinical research, active and healthy ageing, health tourism, and eHealth.
