Total duration: 60 school hours

Prerequisites for participation:

Target group: Disadvantaged people on the labor market - 30 people of Roma origin and 15 people with disabilities.

Knowledge to be acquired:

- Basic knowledge of the labor market at European and national level.
- Knowledge of the main characteristics of the participation of vulnerable persons in the labor market in Romania and Bulgaria.
- How to start your own business Introduction to the challenges of entrepreneurship.
- Basic entrepreneurial skills and their role in business success.
- Characteristics of small business.
- Aspects of training related to issues known as lifestyle entrepreneurship.

Skills for:

- How to look for a job, how to write a cover letter and write a curriculum vitae (CV), how to prepare for a job interview;
- Identification of personal interests, skills and values;
- Building a professional identity
- Development of emotional intelligence;

- Development of the ability to plan the necessary steps to start your own business.
