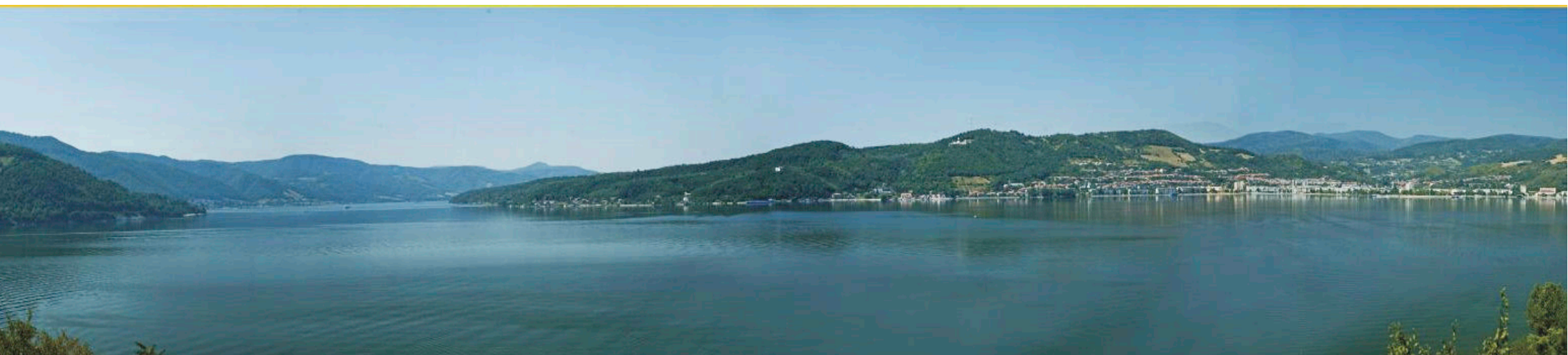

Project context

- Romanian and Bulgarian public authorities are considered bureaucratic, incompetent, and reluctant to perform their duties.
- National Operational Programs have provided trainings for institutional competence which are insufficient to fill the gaps in communication/coordination between authorities and non-governmental organizations/business.
- Bulgaria and Romania ranked in the last two places in the EU in terms of using e-government by individuals in 2014 – immediate action to develop new governance models.

The current situation can only be changed through joint initiatives between all stakeholders and through the implementation of innovative instruments. The project envisages the establishment of a cross-border public-private network that will be the effective mechanism for better communication and interaction between all stakeholders across the cross-border region.

Project goals

Main objective – to promote long-term cooperation between public authorities by creating an efficient and effective innovative tool for better coordination between public and private stakeholders at cross-border level as well as appropriate means of communication and promotion of eGovernment.

Local Authorities in Bulgaria
The Law on Local Self-Government and Local Administration defines local authorities in Bulgaria as the main administrative-territorial units, in which local self-government takes place. Local self-government is carried out by the district and municipal administration.
As the main administrative-territorial unit, in which local self-government takes place, the Constitution defines the municipality. The municipalities can independently form their own management structure and independently form the personal composition of their bodies. The local self-government in the municipality is expressed in the right of the citizens, either individually or through bodies chosen by them, within the competence granted to them to solve issues of local importance.
The district is an administrative-territorial unit that coordinates the activities in the economic, social and cultural sector through the regional administration. It is governed by a governor appointed by the government. There are 28 districts in Bulgaria. In the cross-border area Bulgaria - Romania there are 8 regional administrations.

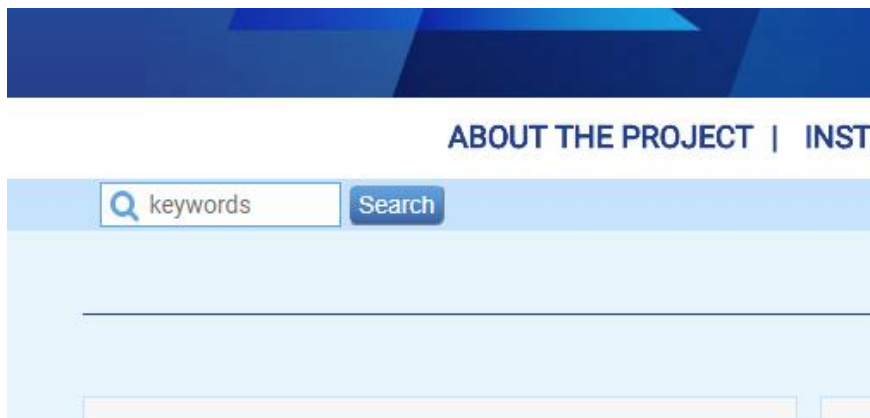
Local government in Romania
Local Councils of municipalities in Romania are a deliberative authority with headquarters in each municipality. The Local Council consists of councillors elected through universal, equal, direct and free vote, under the conditions provided by the Law of Local Elections. The mayor in charge of a municipality is elected according to the law and validated by the court. The mayor performs a position of public authority, under the law. The mayor ensures the observance of the fundamental rights and liberties of the citizens, the provisions of the Constitution, the implementation of the laws, the decrees of the President of Romania, the decisions and ordinances of the Government and the decisions of the Local Council. In order to implement the competencies given by the above normative acts, the mayor benefits from a specialized apparatus that he leads and he is assisted by two deputy mayors, a public administrator and a secretary of the municipality (a public civil servant). The mayor, the deputy mayor, the public administrator, the secretary of the municipality together with the specialty apparatus represent the CITY HALL OF A MUNICIPALITY, a functional structure with permanent activity that fulfills the decisions of the Local Council and the provisions of the mayor, solving the current problems of the local community. There are 7 counties in the cross-border area Bulgaria - Romania.



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Quick search tool

It can quickly find information about a specific city or service. The city name or service name is entered and then the **Search button** is pressed.



Detailed search tool

It can filter the search on the platform very thoroughly. On the left side the institutions can be filtered. It can filter by country by choosing only Bulgaria, only Romania or both countries; by type, by choosing the Municipal administration, Regional administration or both institutions; by Providers, by choosing Electronic Services (all institutions providing electronic services) or Any (including institutions that do not have electronic services). It can also filter by keyword, such as the name of the city or institution. On the right side the services can be filtered.

There are two large buttons at the top for selection of the country for which the search will be filtered. If, for example, **Romania** is selected, the country filter to the left automatically changes to **Romania** and vice versa, if on the left side the filter by country is

selected and **Bulgaria** is selected, then on the right the service filter in **Bulgaria** will be activated. If on the left side a country filter is selected and **Both** is selected, the service filter will show the services for both countries to the right.

To find a service quickly, there is a **"Narrow Search"** search box in which when a keyword is entered, a filter for the services that contain that keyword is displayed. After filtering, there will be a checkbox next to the services that need to be checked (several services can be checked at the same time) so that the filtering can be done by the selected services. Once the user has selected all filters, the Search Institutions button is pressed.

Rousse Municipality is located in Northern Bulgaria. Rousse is the largest Bulgarian city on the Danube River, the most important transport, logistic, economic and cultural center in Northern Bulgaria.



Rousse is the largest Bulgarian city along the Danube River. It is situated on the north-eastern border of Romania with Bulgaria. The town is the administrative center of Rousse and Rousse, as well as an economic, transport, cultural and educational center of regional and national importance. The population of Rousse is 145 745 (according to NII data as of 31.12.2015), which makes it the 5th largest city in Bulgaria.

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MUNICIPALITY OF DOBRICH



Dobrich is a town in northeastern Bulgaria, administrative and business center of Dobrich region and Dobrich municipality.



It is located in the southern part of the Dobruzha geographical area, 34 km from Balchik and 45 km from Varna. The population of the city on December 31, 2015 is 86,292 inhabitants (ninth place in the country)

The town of Dobrich is situated in the Danubian Plain on the Dobruzha plateau. The city is an autonomous municipality and an administrative center of the same name. The territory of the municipality has a total area of 1705 hectares. It is situated along the two banks of the small Dobrich river (Duba Reka) at 220 m above sea level. It is 50 km northwest of Varna, 92 km southwest of Silistra and 34 km southwest of Balchik. The town is preferred by many people because of its good location (about 20 km from the Black Sea coast). It is also famous for the city park "St. George", which is one of the biggest urban parks in Bulgaria and in some places it has a totally untouched nature.

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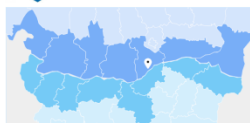
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CITY HALL GIURGIU



Giurgiu is a city in southern Romania. The seat of Giurgiu County, it lies in the historical region of Muntenia.



It is situated amid mud-flats and marshes on the left bank of the Danube facing the Bulgarian city of Ruse on the opposite bank. Three small islands face the city, and a larger one shelters its port, Smarda. The rich grain-growing land to the north is traversed by a railway to Bucharest, the first line opened in Romania, which was built in 1869 and afterwards extended to Smarda. Giurgiu exports timber, grain, salt and petroleum, and imports coal, iron, and textiles.

The Giurgiu Ruse Friendship Bridge, in the shared Bulgarian-Romanian section of the Danube, crosses the river in the outskirts of the city.

Local Council of Giurgiu Municipality is a Deliberative authority with headquarters in Giurgiu Municipality, Bulevardul Bucuresti, nr. 49-51. The Local Council of Giurgiu Municipality consists of 21 councilors elected through universal, equal, direct and free vote, under the conditions provided by the Law of Local Election. The Mayor in charge of Giurgiu Municipality is elected according to the law and validated by Giurgiu Court. The Mayor performs a position of public authority, under the law. The Mayor ensures the observance of the fundamental rights and liberties of the citizens, the provisions of the Constitution, the implementation of the laws, the decrees of the President of Romania, the decisions and ordinances of the Government and the decisions of the Local Council. In order to implement the competencies given by the above normative acts, the Mayor benefits from a specialized apparatus that he leads and he is assisted by two deputy mayors, a public administrator and a secretary of the municipality's public civil servant). The Mayor, the deputy mayor, the public administrator, the secretary of the municipality together with the specialty apparatus represent GIURGIU CITY HALL OF GIURGIU MUNICIPALITY a functional structure with permanent activity that fulfills the decisions of the Local Council and the provisions of the Mayor, solving the current problems of the local community. The Giurgiu City Hall is headquartered in Giurgiu, Bulevardul Bucuresti, nr. 49-51.

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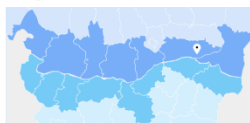

CALARASI CITY HALL



Calarasi City Hall is an important political-administrative, economic and cultural center and it is also the residence of the same named county, Calarasi.



The town is located in the south-eastern part of the country, on the lower terrace of the Danube (Calarasi terrace), at the Danube meadow, on the left bank of the river arm -Borcea. Set at the intersection of the parallel of 44° 12' north latitude and the meridian of 27° 33' east longitude, the city is 120 km far from Bucharest, 144 km far from Constanta and 25 km far from Dragnea (Sun Highway). The city is at the intersection of national roads DN3, DN21 and DN38. Calarasi Municipality is a river port located on the left side of the Danube river, it is located in the south of Calarasi County, on a cross-border area with Bulgaria, with prospects for the development of river and land traffic toward eastern Central Europe and the Balkan Peninsula.
