Step 1 - Define historic place(s)



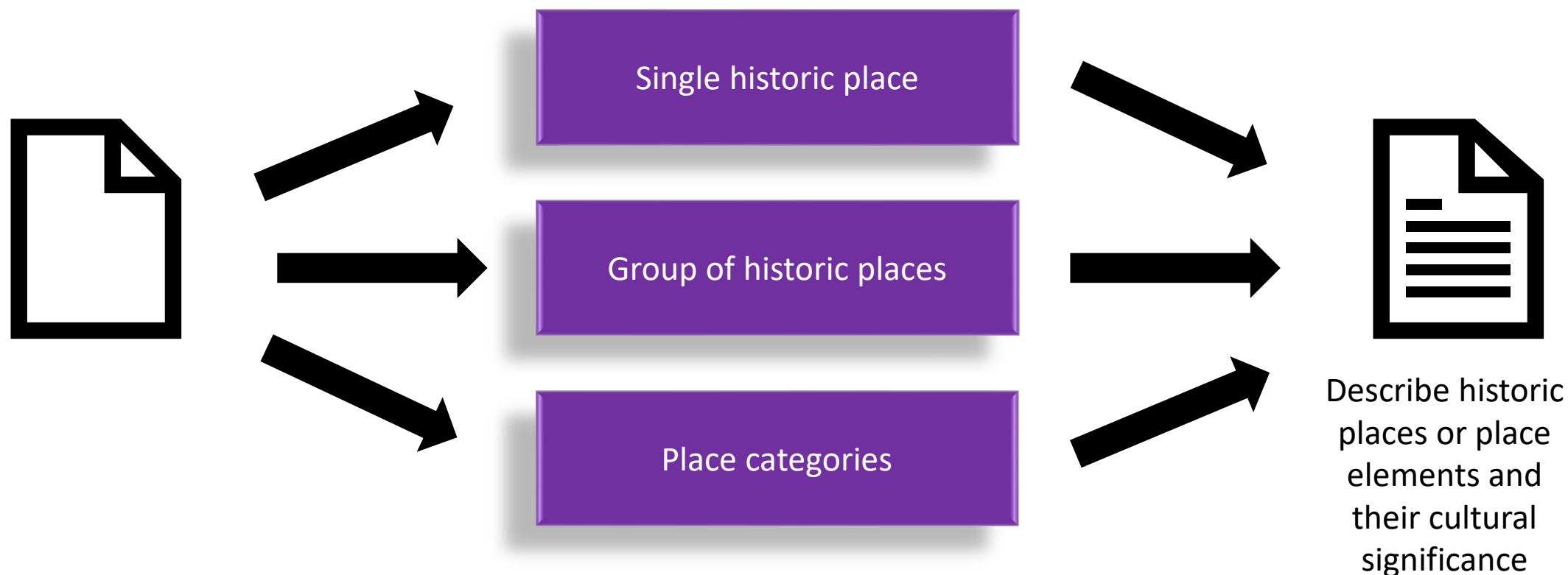
Define historic place(s)
