### **PROBLEM**

- Low health literacy of young children from low-income families;
- Differences in health status between the children from poorer and richer families;
- Lack of modern, attractive and empowering methods for health and social education for children.





## **PROJECT ACTIVITIES**

- Development of the EmpowerKids-tool;
- Trainings for social workers, kindergarten teachers and other users of the tool;
- Interviews with children;
- Healthy workshops.





### **EXPECTED RESULTS**

- empowered children from Latvian, Estonian and Finnish communities, ready to make healthy choices in their daily life (at least 100),
- improved quality of health promotion and social work in participating municipalities,
- increased knowledge of health care personnel, social workers and kindergarten teachers about the tools and methods to work with children from vulnerable groups.





# **PROMISED**

- Involvement of at least 100 children in the activities,
- At least 80 children should benefit from the project,
- At least 2 interview sets in each location,
- Health promoting events 20 for the whole project.
