SUMMARY OF PARTNERS WORK

ACTIVITY 2.3

Activity 2.3 of the project - Regional Study of expectations of employers (Finland, Estonia, and Latvia) was finalized. Three country reports were prepared by partners. HAMK and TTK prepared the Summary of the Country reports (Deliverable 2.3.1). Output of the report has been used in the process of outlining content of EDU-RAIL study modules.

For preparing the implementation of the next activities of the WP 2, on 11.05 the special meeting in Tallinn was organized. Outcomes from country reports and round tables results of the Regional study were presented on the meeting. Guiding notes for activity 2.4 - Comparative study of the best practice of teaching railway engineering were discussed and approved. Discussion was held how to implement the final task of the WP2 - activity 2.5 "Outline of modules by teaching subjects". The visions of TSI, RTU, TTK and KRAO were presented for modules 1,2,3,4 and 5.

Study visit of EDU-RAIL partners to the Lund University and Trafikverksskolan in Ängelsholm, were Bachelor study program of Railway Technology is successfully ongoing, was prepared and prepared and implemented. Desktop study for data collecting of the best practice examples related to bachelor level study programs and VET experience is finished. All partners were involved. Reporting of the Comparative study is in progress and is planned to finish by 31.10.2016.

HAMK and TTK prepared Guidelines for implementing the activity 2.5 - how to outline the EDU-RAIL study modules by list of subjects. Guidelines were commented and accepted by partners. Activity is ongoing and planned to finish by 30.11.2016. .

TSI has prepared and uploaded the leaflet presenting the progress of EDU-RAIL project. TSI have presented EDU-RAIL project on international railway conference "Global Transport Development Vision. Future Challenges" in Riga (http://www.ldz.lv/en/conference-global-transport-development-vision). HAMK and TTK are preparing the next Steering Group and Management team meetings in Riihimäki Finland.
