

The project BOOSTED is about boosting tourism business growth through higher professional education jointly in Finland, Estonia and Latvia. We aim at providing an aligned and relevant skillset of tourism business development for the Central Baltic area. The skills are essential in supporting the area to grow as a coherent tourism destination, to receive more international tourist and to respond jointly to global competition.

In the project we

- identify and align the skills in tourism business development through research activities.
- translate the skills into a joint curriculum of advanced tourism business development.
- implement the curriculum as a joint study programme (32 ects) online in Finland, Estonia and Latvia.

What is there for the education institutions?

There are different possibilities for the vocational and higher education institutions providing tourism degrees and modules to be involved in the project.

- The research results can be utilized for curriculum development purposes.
- The curriculum with its teaching materials will be published in a separate, open access teacher's manual online.
- Coaching events for lecturers will also be organised in Finland, Estonia and Latvia during the spring 2019.

In addition, the existing curricula of HEIs, national and regional tourism strategies have been reviewed. Based on the extensive data relevant skills for curriculum development have been identified. The curriculum of tourism business development for the Central Baltic area will be designed in the autumn 2017.
