The document builds on the Strategy for the Development of Public Personal and Non-Motorized Transport of the Slovak Republic by 2020 and considers an environmental and sustainable point of view. Part of the strategic plan is the analytical part, which compares the vision to the current state and identifies the infrastructure and the operational, organizational and other problems in the individual sectors. The key issues of rail and public passenger transport include for example the underestimated the frequency of service, lack of contralization, lack of renewal of the vehicle fleet, underdeveloped infrastructure, neglected vehicle maintenance, fragmentation of competencies, low rate of preference or insufficient transport spatem of regional transport. 	ZCHFP SR approached the Minister of Transport and Construction of the Slovak Republic by letter and Ministry of Transport initiated a meeting of representatives of ZCHFP SR with departmental directors of the Ministry on strategy and co-financing of multimodality support in Slovakia. Thanks activities of ZCHFP SR within ChemMultimodal Project, the combined transport support program of co-financing has been renewed for more than 10 years.
	 Proposal for financial instruments from Ministry of Transport and Construction of the Slovak Republic was developed and published to support multimodal transport. Concepcion and Financial tool for development multimodality in Slovakia - Koncepcia poskytovania dotácií od roku 2020 do roku 2024 (issued in March 2019 by Ministry of Transport and Construction)) Multimodality development support scheme - Schéma podpory rozvoja Multimodality - started also thanks Association's (ZCHFP SR) activity and Program has been prepared thanks our cooperation
	It includes financial instruments to support new multimodal lines, purchase of transport units, vehicles, repairs, reconstructions of multimodal terminals. Expected costs could be be included in the draft budget of the Ministry of Transport in year 2020. The proposal was discussed on the Meeitngs in March 2019.
	ZCHFP SR have been cooperating with multimodal operators as well as logistics and forwarding companies to promote multimodality and present new logistics solutions for transportation of products and raw materials in chemical industry. Main aim is looking for new solutions and concepts through logistics server and web newsletters and also taking part in international fairs and other events. At conferences and various meetings, we are promoting multimodality and its applications in practice for long haul. We will cooperate in the design of transshipment technology and transshipment solutions directly in enterprises, in the design of company terminals and in the preparation of transports by multimodal block trains.
