1. Introduction

This report includes the results of the D.5.3.2 - n.1 Technical event for Policy Makers. The event was held at the end of the project and organized contextually to the Final Conference to share the proposal developed for fisheries spatial management in the Adriatic Sea, with particular reference to the target species of the project (cuttlefish and common sole), the potential of the MSP tool tested and the most effective practices implemented to enhance and create nursery areas and to promote sustainable farming practices. Moreover, the seminar included a specific section to share with key actors of the EUSAIR Strategic Action Plan in charge of Pillar I and III, the DORY contribution to effective Action plan implementation.

2. Description of the Event: Technical Event for Policy Makers

The “Technical event for Policy Makers” was aimed to transfer the DORY management model and tools towards the policy makers and Managing Authorities/Intermediate Bodies in charge of fisheries policies programming and implementation at regional and national level and, on the other hand, to mainstream project outputs and results in the whole Adriatic Sea Basin.

The event has been conceived in the framework of the Activity “5.2 Knowledge transfer to policy makers” aimed to transfer the DORY management models and tools towards key institutions dealing with fisheries and aquaculture issues and marine environment protection in Adriatic Regions.

Furthermore, during the event, has been shared the summary of the “EUSAIR contribution document outlining DORY contribution for the effective implementation of EUSAIR Strategic Plan, with Particular Reference on Pillar I and III. The document has been drafted by Veneto Region which also represents one of the Regional Focal Point for Italy within the TSG of the Pillar 1 of the EUSAIR strategy.

As mentioned before the event was held on the 19th of September 2019 in Venice (the day before the Final Conference). Save the date and agenda about the final conference and the technical event for Policy makers has been sent to all the FEAMP Intermediate Organism and bodies involved in its implementation. Italian Regions outside the IT-HR Programme and Intermediate Organisms of the EMFF has been invited to the final events of DORY Project.
