TRANSPOGOOD project was present during the adriLon meeting of the NewBrain project, Interreg Adrion.

On the 6th June 2019, Elevante, project partner of the Transpogood project presented the project at the AdriLon meeting of the Interreg Adrion project NewBrain. NewBrain aims at boosting the relevance of the Adriatic-Ionian core nodes system for the economic and social integration of the programme area, in the framework of the European transport policy and TEN-T network as key gates
