## Mission

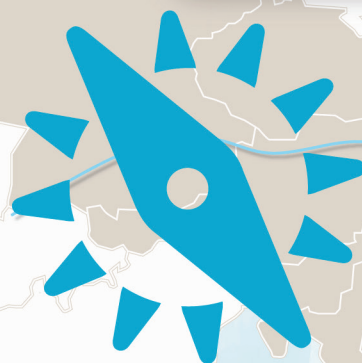
1. To improve public institutions' capacities to support migrant integration
2. To facilitate easier access of migrants to employment and other services
3. To contribute to effective information infrastructure for migrants in the Danube region

## Points of Departure

1. Lack of transnational cooperation in information sharing
2. Scattered and partial information sources available for migrants and those working with migrants
3. Uneven development of information infrastructure for migrants across the Danube region despite the regions' interconnected migration movements
4. Individual best-practices failed to be implemented on the systemic level

## Reaching Out

1. Pilot actions: **294** public institutions' employees & migrants included
2. Trainings for public institutions: **204** employees participated
3. Workshops with decision-makers: almost **100** decision-makers from the region included
4. **6000** Migrants & refugees directly targeted



## Strategy for the future

1. Putting access to information for migrants on the agenda of public institutions in the Danube region
2. Working with local decision-makers on improving national information infrastructure for better integration outcomes
3. Searching for transnational solutions in information dissemination
4. Focusing on clear, easy to understand and fair access to information
