CAPACITY BUILDING TRAININGS TO STREIGHTHEN CAPACITY OF THE LOCAL PRODUCERS

New trainings organized in Republic of Moldova and Greece

The "Business Advisory Center — BAC" NGO, (Asociatia Obsteasca "Centrul de Consultanta in Afaceri") Moldova organized the first 2 days training (from the 5 days program) addressed to the local producers of berries, in the frame of the project "Sustainable Agricultural Trade Network in the Black Sea Basin" AgriTradeNet, BSB 383.

The first training, entitled "Business development with traditional fruit's products, with Geographical Identity" (20/08/2019) had a special information partner - the State Agency for Intellectual Property (AGEPI). The expert, Mr. A. Fala familiarized the participants with national GI products and the marketing channels, was explained the registration process of GI products, was presented the potential for export of GI Products to EU markets, additionally was discussed some regional GI products.

The second training, entitled "Eco Farming - how to become an organic producer" (22/08/2019) was lead by the Mr. V. Pintelei as expert and had a special guest, the "BioChemTech"LLC. The participants got acquainted with the management of organic farming, drafted the steps of ecological conversion and certification, under what conditions can be sold the organic products in the country and in EU. "BioChemTech" familiarized the producers with ecological technologies on combating the "hairy beetle". At least 60 participants as local producers and farmers, representatives of interested local producers' associations and central administrative authorities, attended the events.
