CONSTRUCTION WORKS IN DEMIRKOY, TURKEY

Demirkoy Municipality realized the small scale investment works in Demirkoy, Turkey for the constrcution of a tourist - local products center where people visiting the region will be informed and local products will be presented to everyone. The new constrcuted building, including 10 offices, will be used by the local producers' unions, organizations and cooperatives. There, the local producers will have a chance to promote their agricultural products and, at the following stage, the Municipality of Demirkoy will provide these offices to the local organizations and institutions representing the agricultural producers, on the base of determinant criteria.
