ABOUT SLOVENSKA BISTRICA

Slovenska Bistrica, built on the remains of the Roman settlement and now a modern Slovenian city, is interesting to explore and delve into the life in the past. The region is marked by preserved castles and castles and ruins of former forts, numerous churches and shrines. While the work and life of the locals is also testified by preserved ethnological and other cultural monuments, crafts and customs, which are still nurtured by many individuals and associations.

Handicraft was very active and prosperous even back in the day. The Art and Craft Centre is in charge of preserving that part of the local cultural heritage today.

Another thing to see and experience is the Slovenska Bistrica Castle with numerous permanent collections and the Knights' Hall with famous frescoes,



the castle park with the avenue lined by hornbeam, the church of St. Martin in Šmartno na Pohorju with renowned Roman frescoes, the antique settlement Ančnikovo gradišče, Black lake on Pohorje, Bistriški vintgar with the Roman white marble quarry along the Bistrica stream, on which many mills and sawmills once operated...

The geographically diverse region is ideal for many different activities, mainly for cycling, trail running, hiking and also skiing on Pohorje in winter.

We hope you decide to visit us and dive into the experience of handicraft making, learn about the rich cultural, natural and industrial heritage, and get to know our town a little differently.

ESCAPE ROOM „THE LOST ELEMENT“

Escape Room is conceived as an exhibition of craftsmanship, handicraft and industry in the area of Slovenska Bistrica. But something strange is happening there at night. The entire building is shaking severely... Do you dare to enter the exhibition and help us reveal the secret? In this intense game that we called the Lost element the present intertwines with the past, and visitors are on an important mission: to find the lost element, to save our city. Escape from the craft workshop is an entertaining and educational experience, where visitors learn about a range of tools used in the past by craftsmen. The game is appropriate for groups of 2 - 5 players who have 1 hour to find the final element by joining forces and knowledge.

In the creative workshop focused on designing products from recycled aluminium you can make your own pendant, ring or other pieces of jewellery.

Attendees will see what tools are used for designing jewellery and learn about ancient handicraft techniques, such as manual forging, repoussage (hammering), toreutics (situla art; chasing, carving, and embossing in metal). The use of the recycled industrial aluminium from the Slovenska Bistrica factory Impol highlights the meaning of reuse. Let your imagination run free.



WATER AND CLAY

Walk among the abandoned clay pit ponds and admire interesting and diverse animal and plant species that live here now. There are currently 12 clay pit ponds. Along the deserted clay pits visitors can now enjoy sports and tourist fishing, learning and recreational paths and many other things. The path takes you to the water tower, where you can admire a collection of railway-related objects which were once used on the rail road. You will learn about the water tower, and also why the railroad car that stands along the old locomotive used to be called a "cowboy" car.

Noble Isabella is creamy honey with added lyophilized grapes Izabela, which gives honey its unique and classy taste, currently unknown to the world, but this further makes it truly unique and one-of-a-kind. It is packed in cardboard packaging that wraps the entire product. On the outer side of the wrapping is a relief of Ritoznoj in black and white. On the back side of the wrapping is a short story about the izabela grape variety with reference to the tradition of winegrowing and arts and craft in Slovenska Bistrica. Next to the relief is also a printed seal of Slovenska Bistrica. Noble Isabella creamy honey is a perfect addition to dishes, since it can be used as a dressing or topping, and thanks to its thick structure it can also be used as a bread spread or a fine addition to pastry, cakes, ice cream, rolled dumplings, meat dishes, and the list goes on and on.
